Component: Button

1 Overview

The Core Component Button component allows the author to add a button on a page.

2 Business Use Case

Button component is use full in such scenario where other components on the page doesn't have CTA capabilities OR scenarios like we just need a button on the page somewhere so this is the component which can be used.

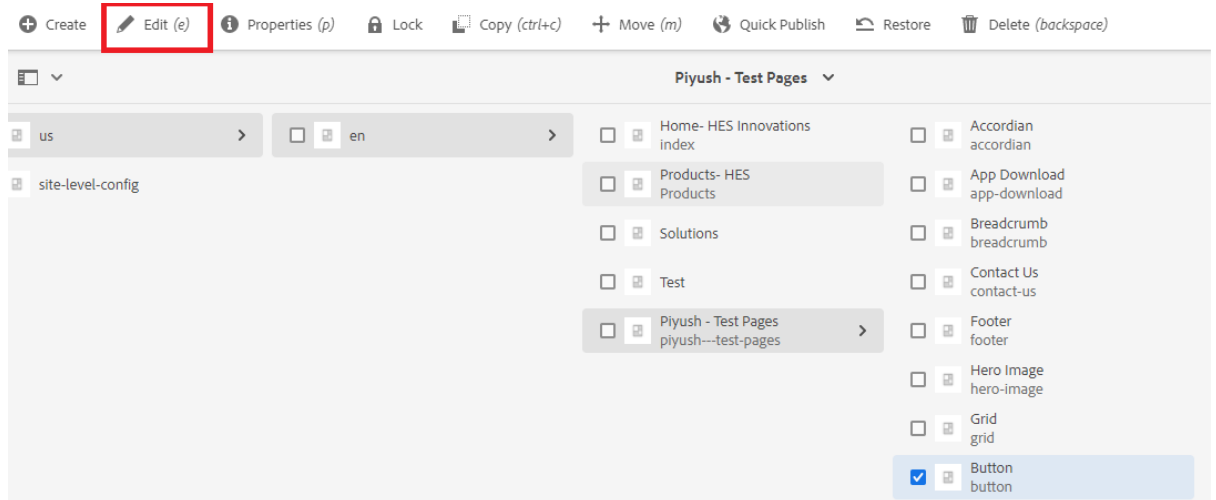
3 Design

This Button component contains the following properties.

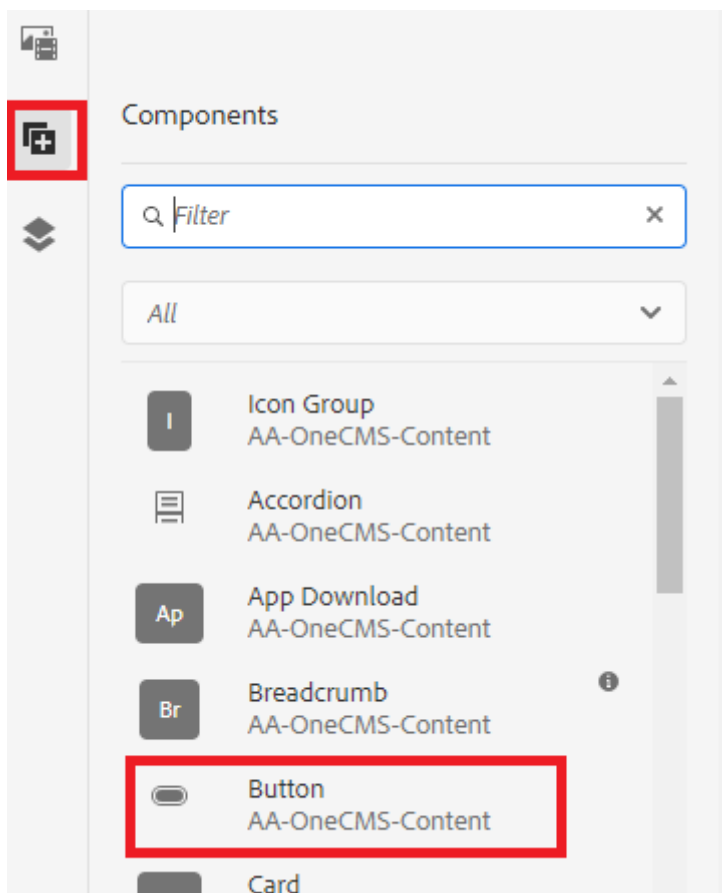
- **isEnabled** – It a toggle button to decide if the button must be enabled or disabled.
- **Button Text** – This is to capture the label/text for the button
- **CTA Path** – This is to capture the page URL which should open on click of the button
- **Button Size** – This is to define the size of the button. It has 2 values i.e. Small and Big
- **Variant** – This is to decide the variant of the button. It has following 5 values
 - Primary
 - Secondary
 - Inverted
 - Light Link
 - Dark Link
- **Open in different tab** – Tis is to decide the URL given in CTA Path should open in the same window or a new window.

4 Authoring Steps

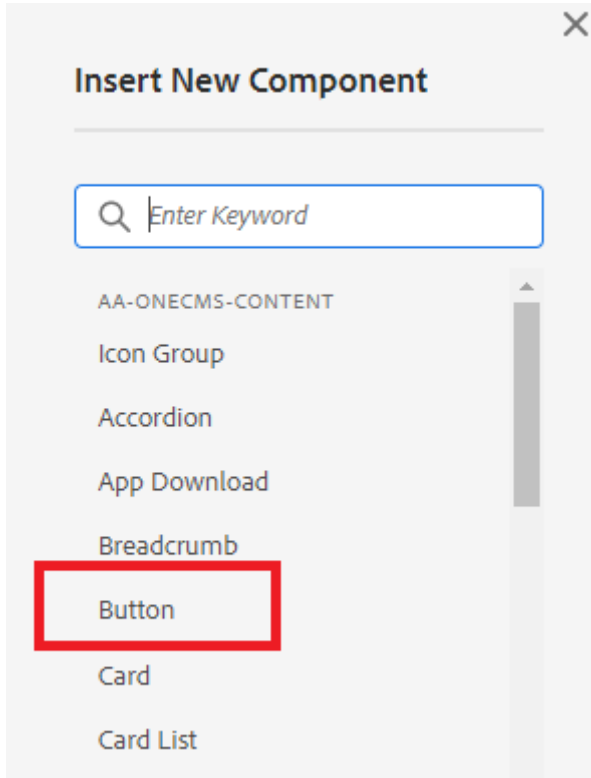
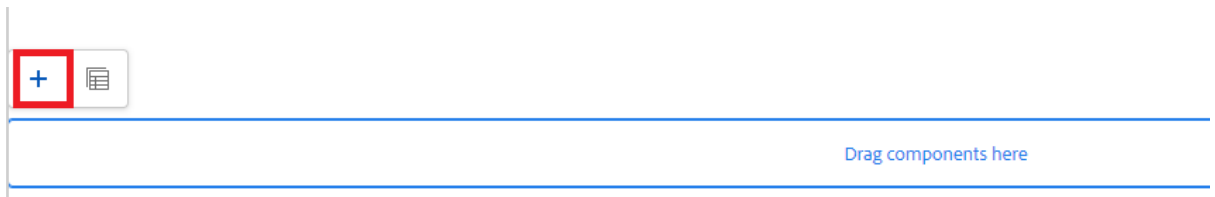
- **Step 1:** Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option



- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Button component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container. Or choose it from the available component list

- Step 3: Configure the Button Component.



- Step 4: Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as per following table:

S. No	Field Title	Field Type	Field Description	Mandatory (Yes/No)
1	isEnabled	Toggle	To decide if the button should be enabled or disabled	No (default is set to disabled)
2	Button Text		To specify the text for button	Yes
3	CTA Path	Tag	To specify the URL which should open on click on button	No

4	Button Size	Dropdown	To select the size of the button	No (default is small)
5	Variant	Dropdown	To select the variant of the button	No (default is primary)
6	Open in different tab	Dropdown	To select if the provided URL should open in the same window or a new window	No (default is set to No)

- Step 5: Click “Done”.
- Step 6: The Button component will now be visible on the Page and can be previewed.
