1 Overview

Carousel Component allows the content author to present content in a navigable carousel. We would be providing below details,

- List slides in carousel
- Sliding details in the component
- Play speed

2 Business Use Case


Using the Carousel Component, the content author can organize content in a rotating carousel of slides. Use a Carousel component when you have a set of featured items with images/videos that you want to display in form of carousel. The Carousel component typically resides on your site's home page but can be placed on any page in your site.

3 Design

This Carousel component contains the authoring for Carousel Slides and Its carousel's base properties like title, Auto play, Transition delay time.


4 Authoring Steps

- Step 1: Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.
- Step 2: Once the Page is opened, insert the carousel component into the page. It can be achieved via either of following ways:
 - Go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Carousel component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Container.







 Double click on the placeholder which is denoted by "Drag Components here" or click on the plus icon available on the placeholder and choose Carousel from the provided list of components.




➤ <u>Step 3</u>: Now Select the Carousel component and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.




> Step 4: Enter the Details with respect to each carousel slide in Asset tab. Add slides by using add button:




Step 5: Enter the information wrt each slide as:








Step 6: Enter the Carousel Title, Auto transition Slides and Transition delay information in Properties tab:
