# Component: Click to Content

## 1 Overview

Click to content works in parallel to the Tab Container component. Anything added in the Tab container displays as the tab name in the click to content component. Clicking in the click to content tabs, user will be redirected to that particular section defined by the tab container.

**It is advised to refer the authoring of tab container also to author the click to content component.**

## 2 Business Use Case

The Click to Content component is used to quickly get to the content on the page using tab containers. There will be a tab for each tab container and when we click on that tab it will redirect our focus to that particular tab container's data.

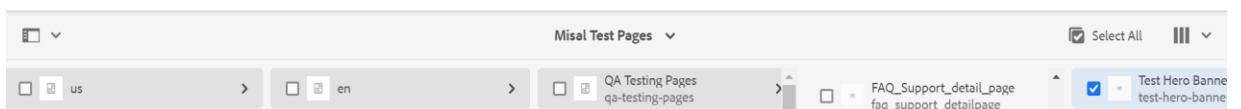
## 3 Design

This Click to Content component contains the General and Display design. CTC component includes combinations of below fields:

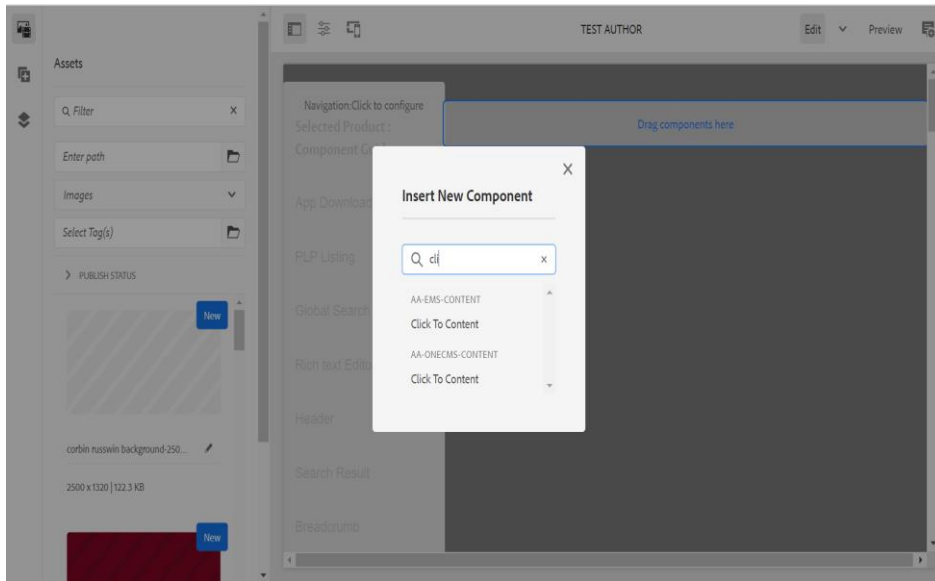
- Tab Alignment

## 4 Authoring Steps

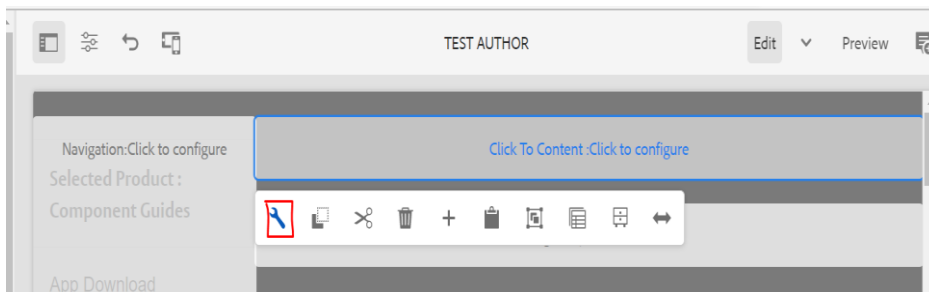
- **Step 1:** Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.



- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Click to Content component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container.



- **Step 3:** Select the Click to Content component and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.



- **Step 4:** Enter the details in the General tab as shown below.
