Component: Hero Banner

1 Overview

Hero Banner is the component which allows the author to display a bigger image like a banner at the top of the page mostly, but this component allows to display the image anywhere on the page.

3 Design

This hero banner component contains the following tabs with different properties.

Image Tab

- Image – This is to capture the image to be displayed in desktop version.
- Tablet Image - This is to capture the image to be displayed in tablet version.
- Mobile Image - This is to capture the image to be displayed in mobile version.
- Image Alt Text - This is to capture the text in case there is no image.

Text Tab

- Description layout – This is to define the layout for description to be displayed. It has 2 values for selection
 - Normal – This is the default layout
 - Right
- Title - This is to capture the title to be displayed on the image.
- Description – This is to capture the description to be displayed on the image.
- Text Color – This is to capture the text color
- Text background – This is to capture the text background color.

CTA Tab

- CTA Text – This is to capture the text to be displayed on the button

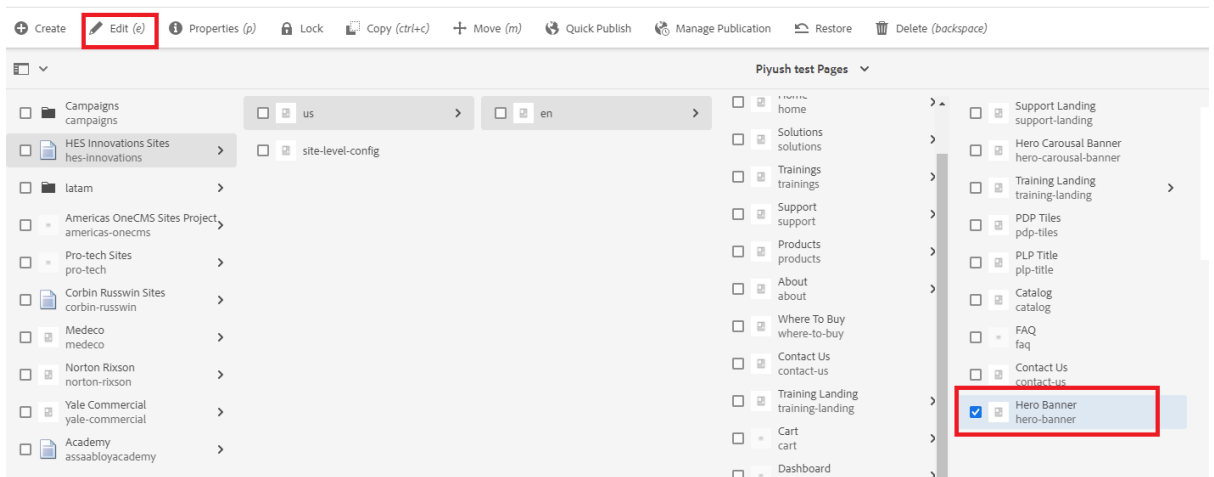
- CTA Path – This is to capture the CTA path (URL)
- Target – This is to define if the authored URL should open in the same tab or in a new tab

Display Tab

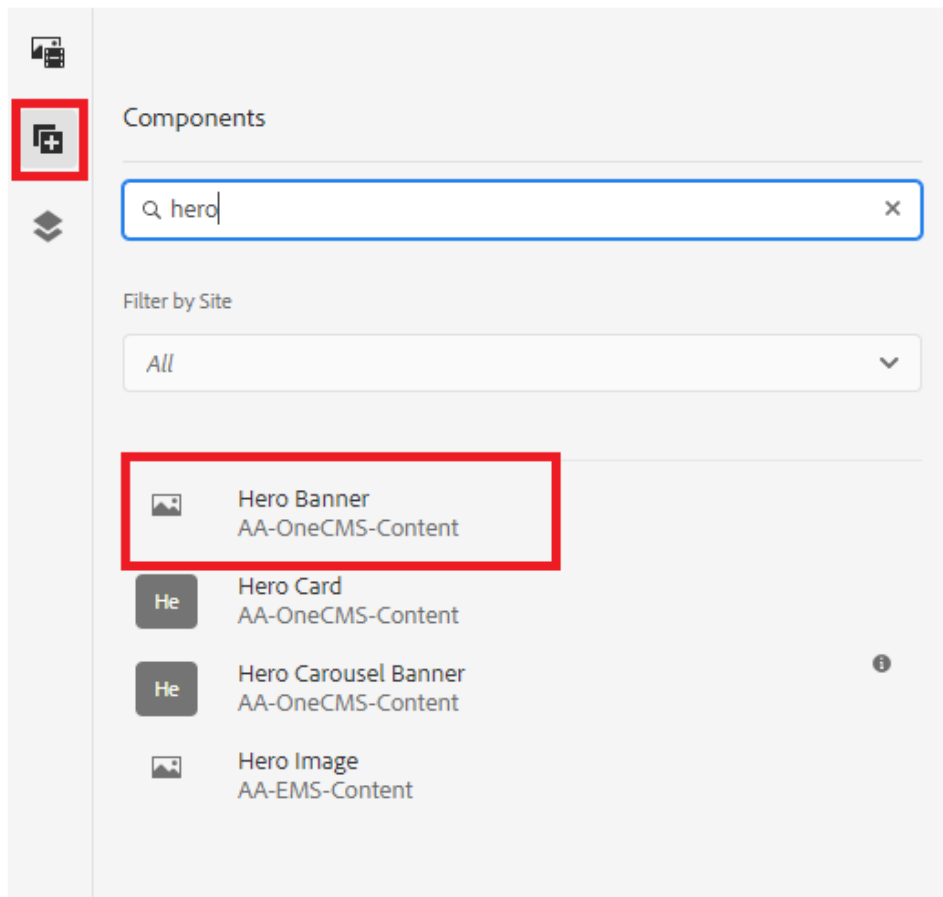
- Background Color Options – This is to define the background color for the banner. It has 2 options for selections.
 - Grey
 - White

4 Authoring Steps

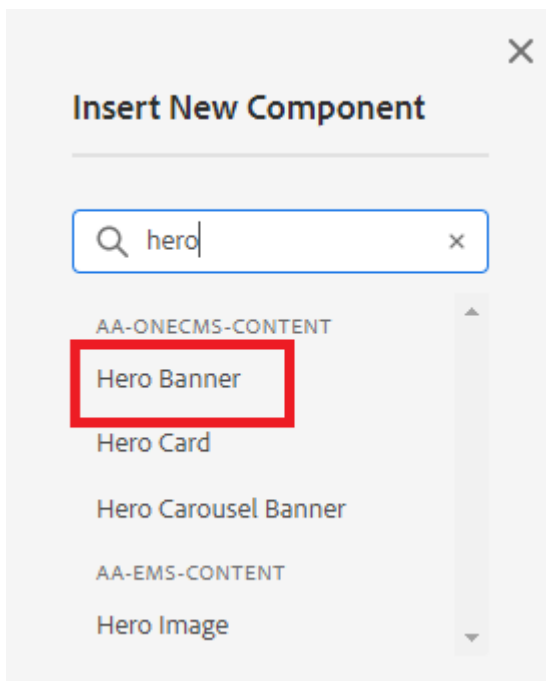
- Step 1: Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.



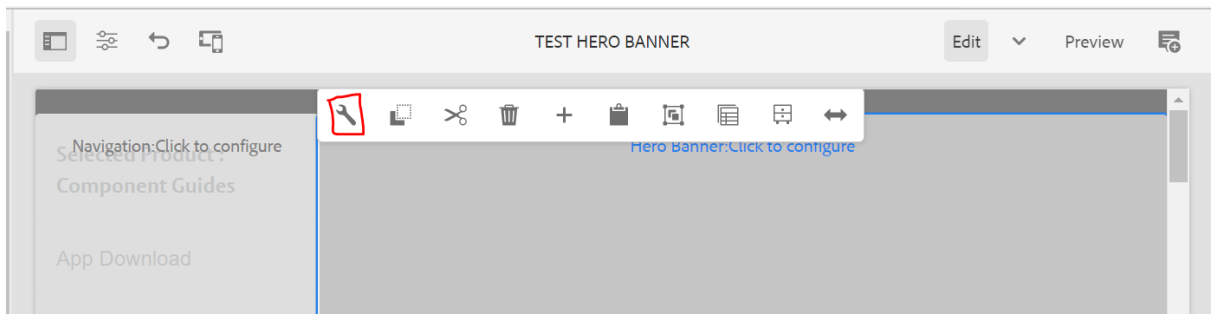
- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Hero Banner component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container Or choose it from the available component list



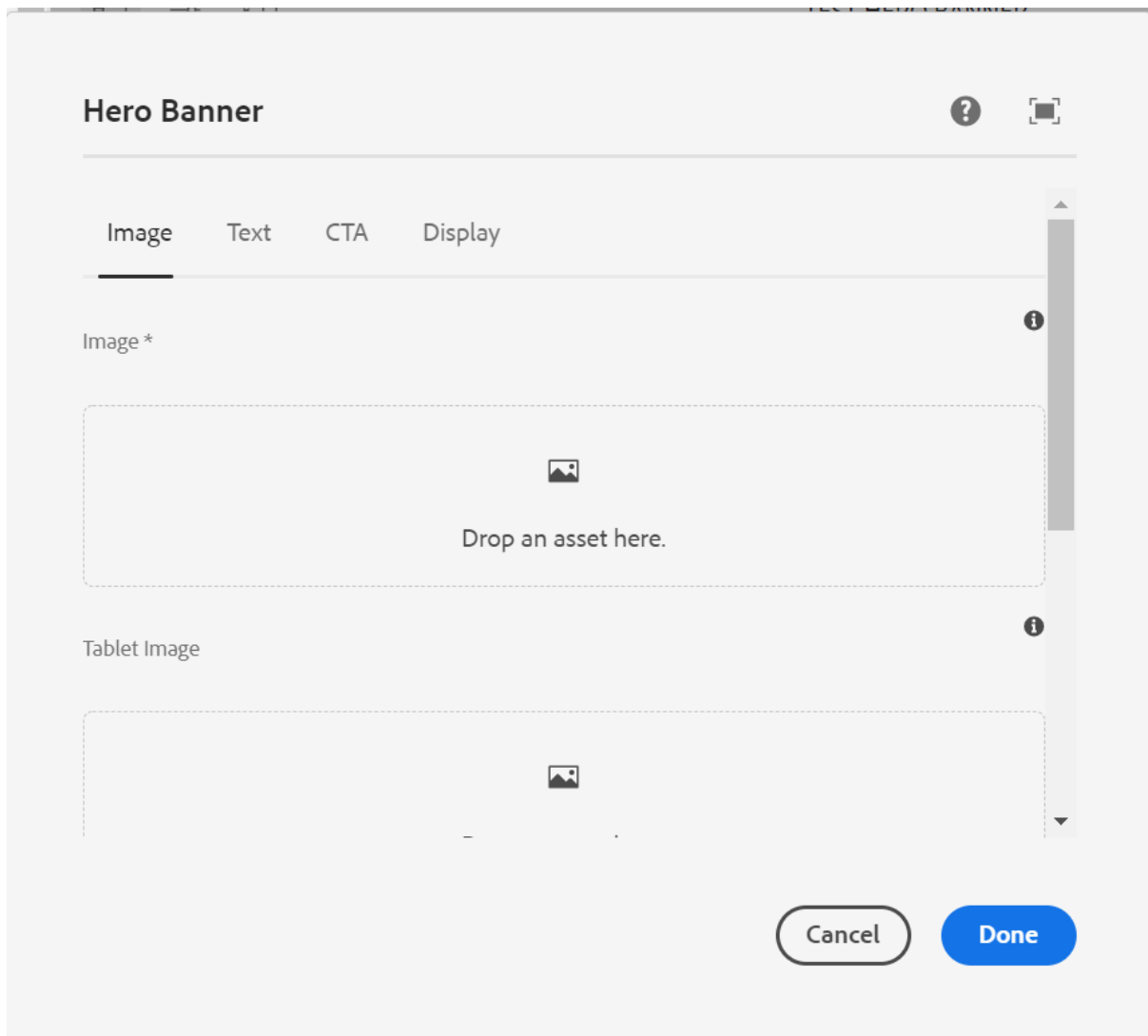

- **Step 3:** Select the Hero Banner component and click on the wrench icon to open the component authoring dialog.



- **Step 5:** Hero banner Dialog. It will consist of Image, Alt Text, Title, Description, CTA Text, CTA Link, Alignment

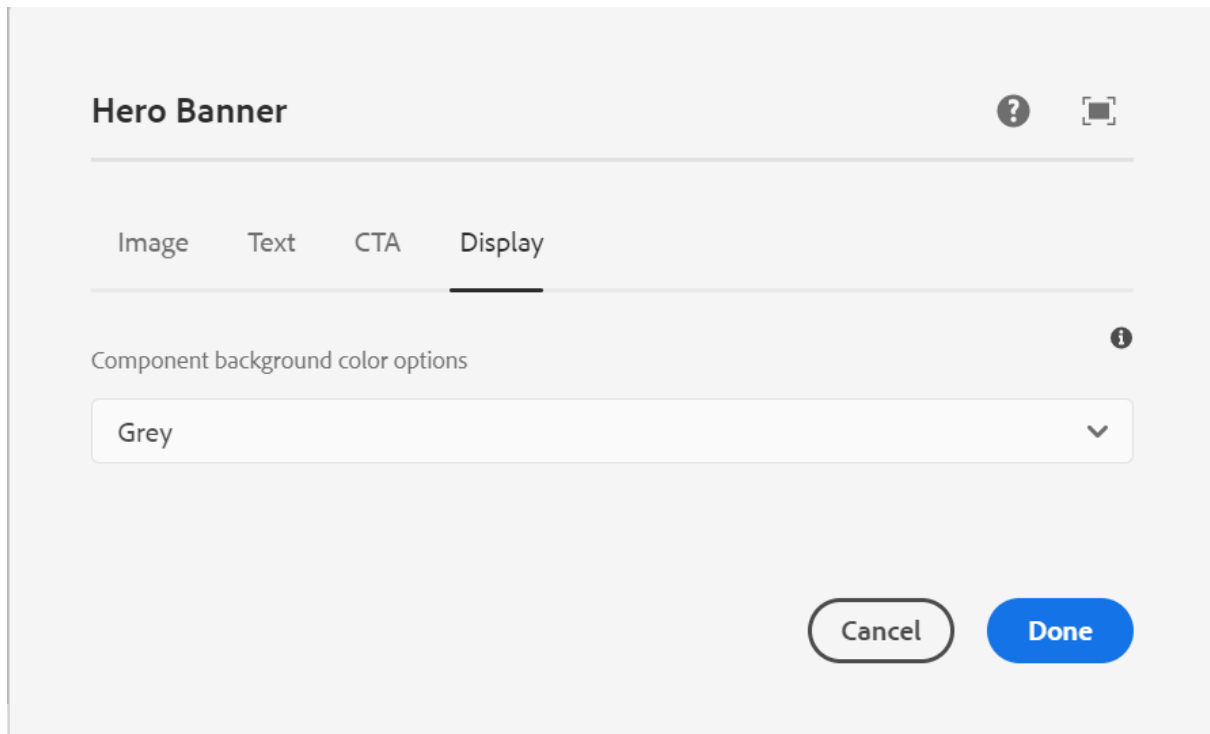

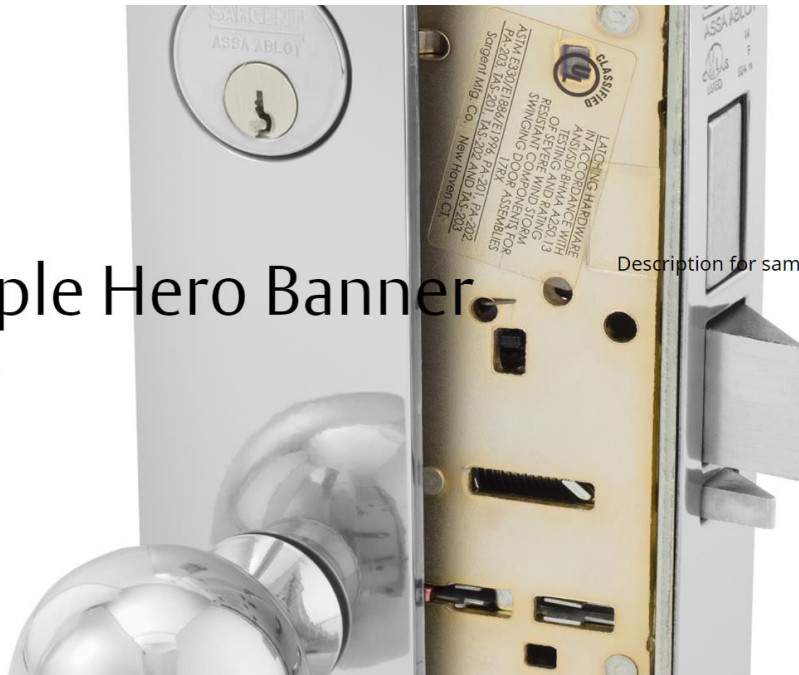
➤ Step 6: Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table.

S. No	Field Title	Field Type	Field Description	Mandatory (Yes/No)
1	Image	Upload/Drag-Drop (for Image)	Image for desktop view	Yes
2	Tablet Image	Upload/Drag-Drop (for Image)	Image for tablet view	No
3	Mobile Image	Upload/Drag-Drop (for Image)	Image for mobile view	No
4	Image Alt Text	Text Field	Enter ALT Text for Image	Yes
5	Description layout	Dropdown	To define the layout of description. Default is Normal - Normal - Right	Yes (default is Normal)
6	Title	Text Field	Enter the title.	No
7	Description	RTE (Rich Text Editor)	Enter the description	No
8	Text Color	Select (options)	Select Color options	No
9	Text Background Color	Select (options)	Select Color options	No
10	CTA Text	Text Field	Enter the text for Button/Link	No
11	CTA Link	Path Field	Enter the link to which button/text will be re-directed.	No
12	Target	Dropdown	To select if the CTA Path should open in the same tab or in a new tab	Yes (default is same tab)
13	Background Color Options	Dropdown	To select the background color - Grey - White	Yes (default is grey)
