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Component: Mini Banner

1 Overview

The Core Component Mini Banner component allows the author to add a component on a page with Image, with a title, some description & a CTA on it.

2 Business Use Case

Mini Banner component is use full in such scenario where there is a need to display an Image with a title, description, and a CTA on the image. This component can be added anywhere on the page.

NOTE – This component provides local search ability as well, but underline functionality has been moved to phase2 development so for the purpose of this authoring guide, please ignore “Search Box Config” tab from component authoring dialogue and during authoring of this component please disable the search.

3 Design

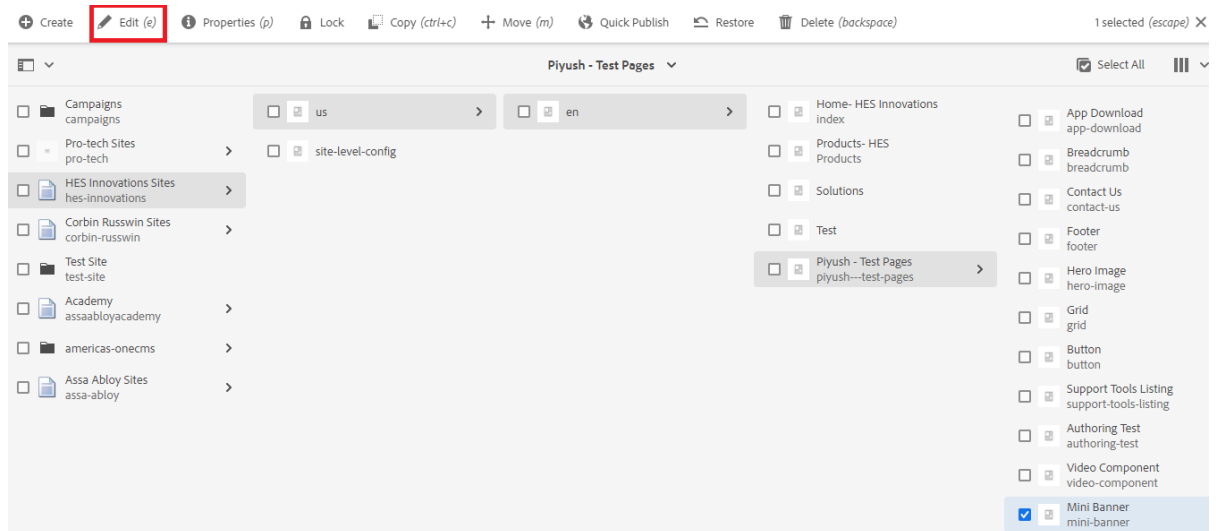
This Mini Banner component contains the following properties.

- **Title** – This is to capture the title to be displayed on the image.
- **Description** – This is to capture the description to be displayed on the image
- **Image** – This is to capture the image to be displayed as banner
- **Image Alt Text** – This is to capture the alt text to displayed.
- **CTA Text** – This is to capture the text for the CTA
- **CTA Path** – This is to capture the URL of the page which should open on click of the CTA.
- **CTA Target** – This is to select if the URL should open in the same window or a new window.
- **CTA Theme** – This is to select the theme for the CTA. It has following values for selection.
 - Primary
 - Secondary
 - Inverted
 - Light Link
 - Dark Link

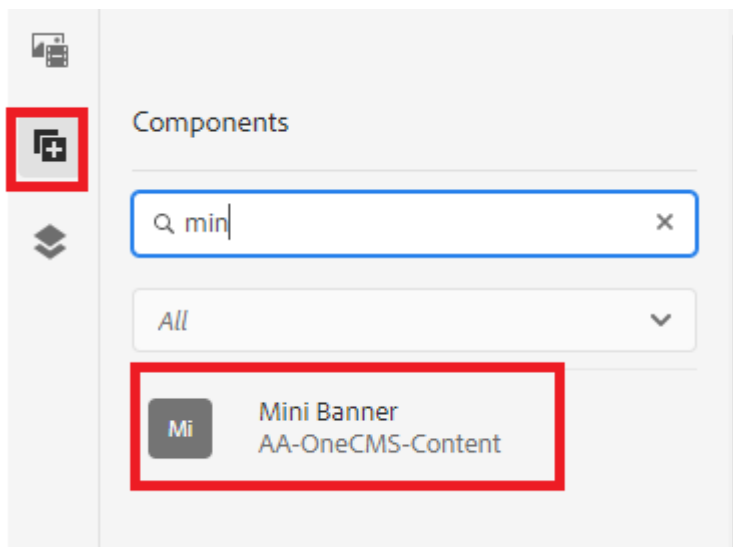
Authoring dialogue of this component also has a tab named as “Search Box Config” which needs to be ignored for now.

4 Authoring Steps

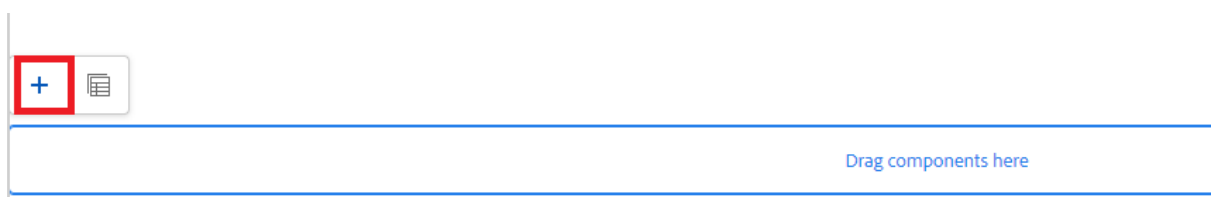
- **Step 1:** Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option

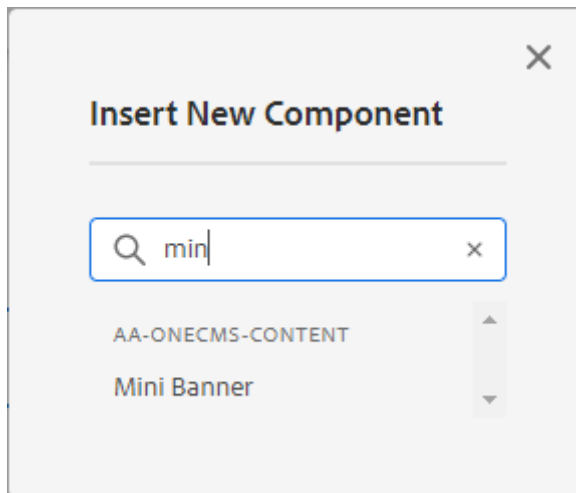


- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Mini Banner component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container. Or choose it from the available component list






- **Step 3:** Configure the Mini Banner Component. Currently we need to configure “Mini Banner” tab only.

➤ Step 4: Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as per following table:

S. No	Field Title	Field Type	Field Description	Mandatory (Yes/No)
1	Title	Input Box	This is to capture the title to be displayed on the image	Yes
2	Description	Rich text Box	This is to capture the description to be displayed on the image	No
3	Image	Image	This is to capture the image to be displayed as banner	No
4	Image Alt Text	Input Box	This is to capture the alt text to displayed	No
5	CTA Text	Input Box	This is to capture the text for the CTA	No
6	CTA Path	Tag Selector	This is to capture the URL of the page which should open on click of the CTA. This path could be a link to internal page or an external page.	No
7	CTA Target	Dropdown	This is to select if the URL should open in the same window or a new window. It has 2 values, - Self - Blank (New Tab)	No (default is self)

8	CTA Theme	Dropdown	This is to select the theme for the CTA. It has following values for selection. It has 5 values, - Primary - Secondary - Inverted - Light Link - Dark Link	No (default is primary)
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- Step 5: Go To “Search Box Config” tab and deselect “Enable Search Box” checkbox.
- Step 6: Click “Done”.
- Step 7: The Mini Banner component will now be visible on the Page and can be previewed.
