1 Overview

The Navigation component allows to create a section in the page which can be used to easily navigate across different pages configured under that navigation component added.

2 Business Use Case


Allows for easy user navigation across pages from a single page section remaining in the same page view.

3 Design


Can be placed in any page and used with just configuring the root page link.

4 Authoring Steps


- Step 1: Open a page in editor mode



- Step 2: Open the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and drag the Navigation component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container




Or choose it from the available component list.





- Step 3: Select the Navigation component on the page and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.





- Step 4: Select the Navigation Root for which navigation need to be placed in the page.


