# Component: Quick Links

#### 1 Overview

Quick links are a collection of links to frequently used application pages like Get Support, FAQ's etc. It allows the author to provide maximum 4 access points to their users that should be accessible all the time irrespective of page and scroll position.

#### 2 Business Use Case


Quick Links Component displays a collection of links which is accessible to users all the time irrespective of page.

## 3 Design

The Quick Links component contain multilink so that user can add links on a page which they want to access frequently like like Get Support, Toolkit etc. Once all the options are selected and saved, it will generate quick links on the page, where max links that can be entered is 4 and minimum should be 1.


# 4 Authoring Steps

> Step 1: Open a page in editor mode.







> Step 2: Open the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab



➤ <u>Step 3</u>: Drag the Quick Links component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container.




> Step 4: Select the Quick Links component on the page and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog








Click on Add Button and click Expand/Collapse to enter details of the Quick Links that we need.
