2 Business Use Case

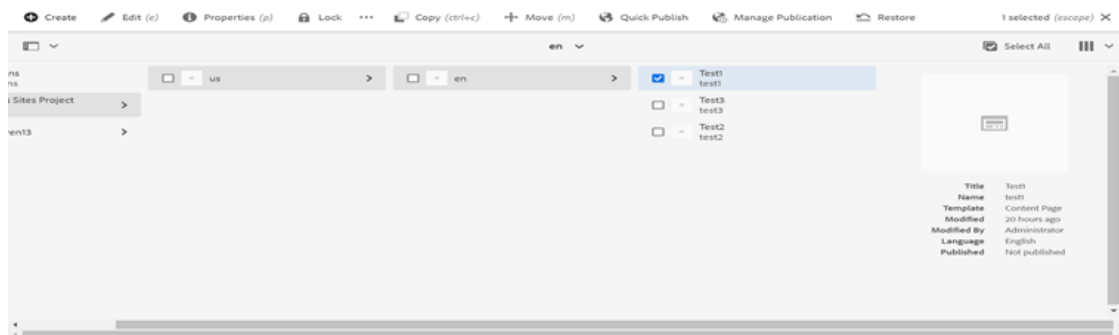
It is a way to display social media images which takes the end user to corresponding social media page.

3 Design

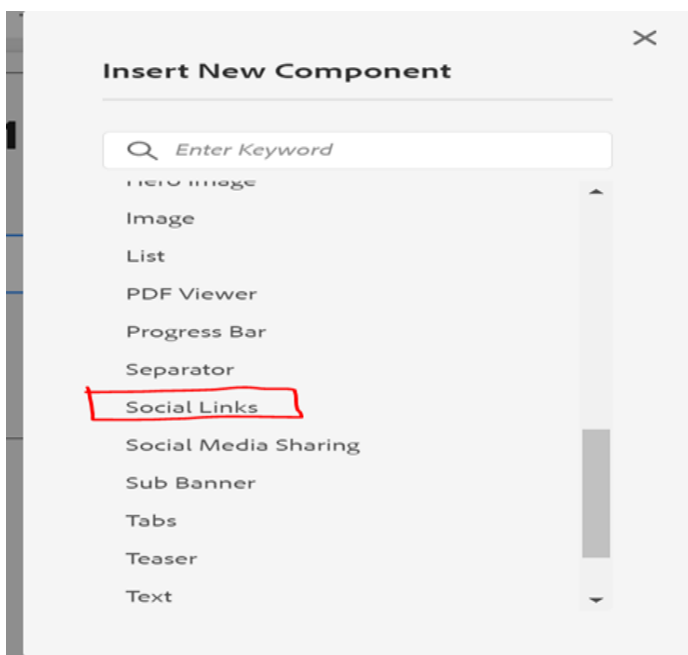
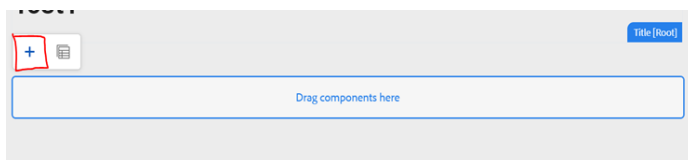
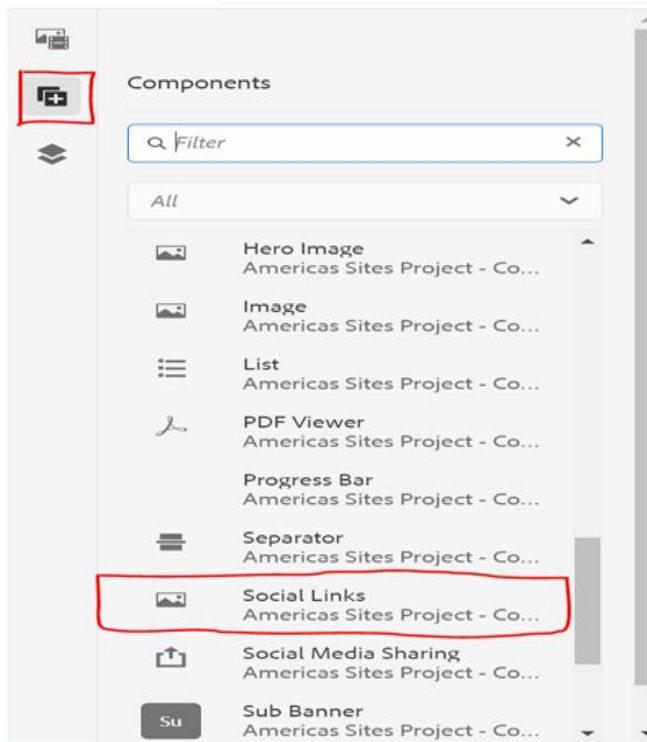
This social links component contains the authoring for social links heading and social links items. Social Links Items contain -> Image, Image Alt Text, Social Links Url.

4 Authoring Steps

- Step 1: Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.




- Step 2: Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and drag the Social Links Component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container. Or choose it from the available component list




- **Step 3:** Select the Social Links component and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.



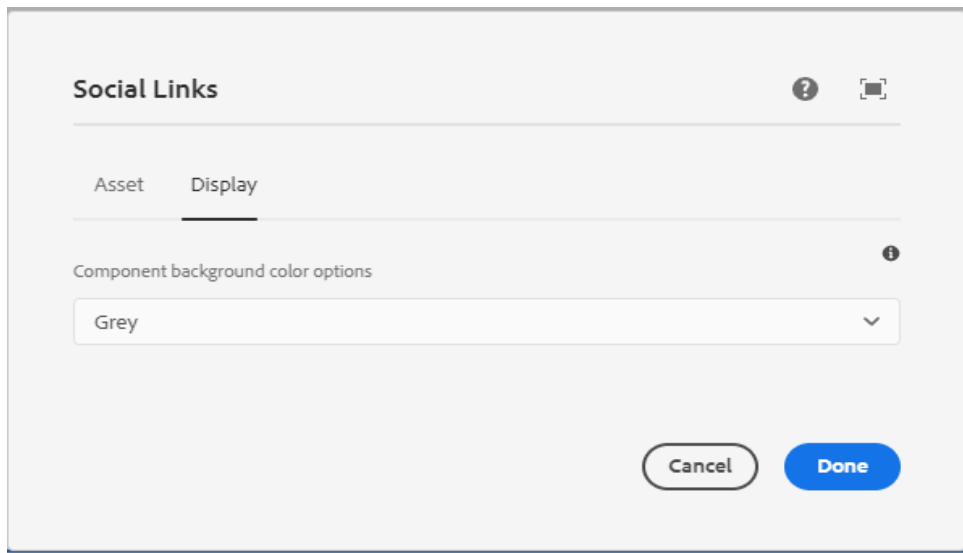
- **Step 4:** Enter the Social Links details in Social Links Dialog as per below snap



- **Step 5:** Go to Asset tab and click Add to add and configure required social links.



- **Step 6:** Use the Display tab to configure the component background color.



- **Step 7:** Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table.
