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# Component: Sub Banner

## 1 Overview

Sub Banner component allows web authors to display a banner with a single image and options such as a caption, text, and CTAs on web page.

## 2 Business Use Case

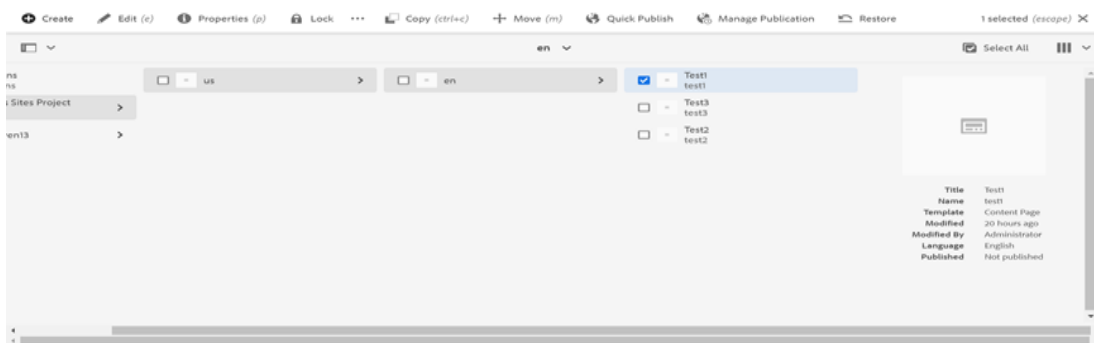
It is a way to easily display a prominent message to end users in a way that is less transient than a snack bar and less obtrusive than a dialog, so the Banner can be configured to display some important heading or advertisement to appear on a web page.

## 3 Design

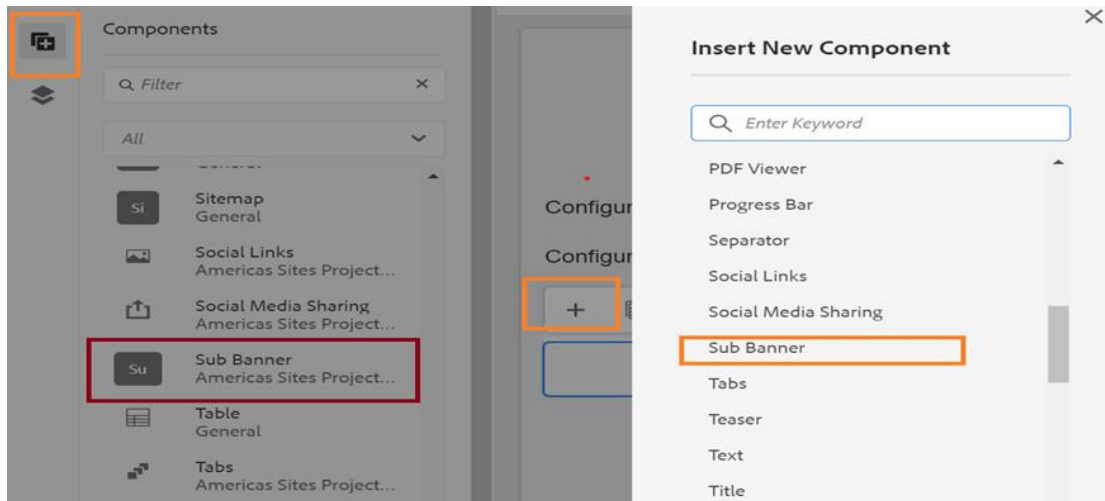
This sub banner image component contains the authoring for image, image alt text, title, description, CTA text, CTA Link, Alignment.

## 4 Authoring Steps

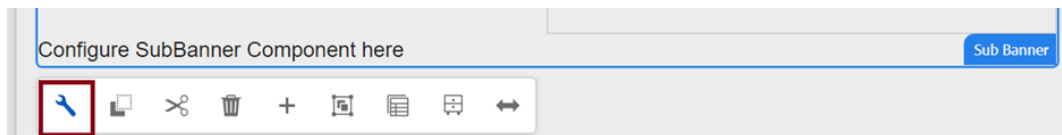
- **Step 1:** Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.



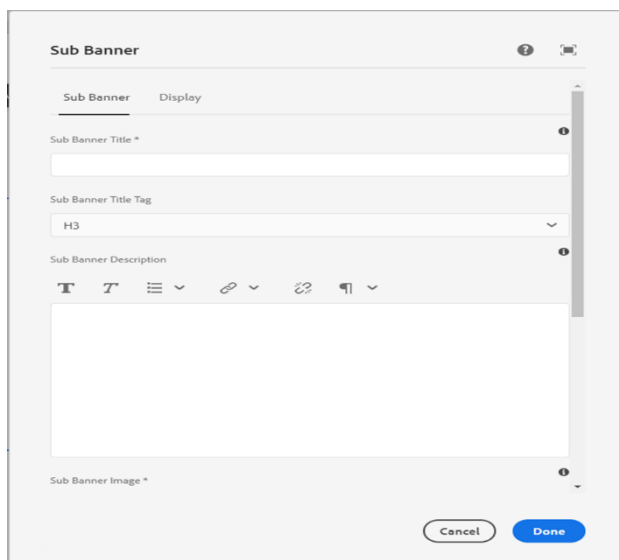
- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Sub Banner component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container. Or choose it from the available component list



- **Step 3:** Select the Sub Banner component and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.



- **Step 4:** Enter the ASSA Sub Banner details in Sub Banner dialog as per below snap.
