It is a way to display Text Image which takes the end user to corresponding link.

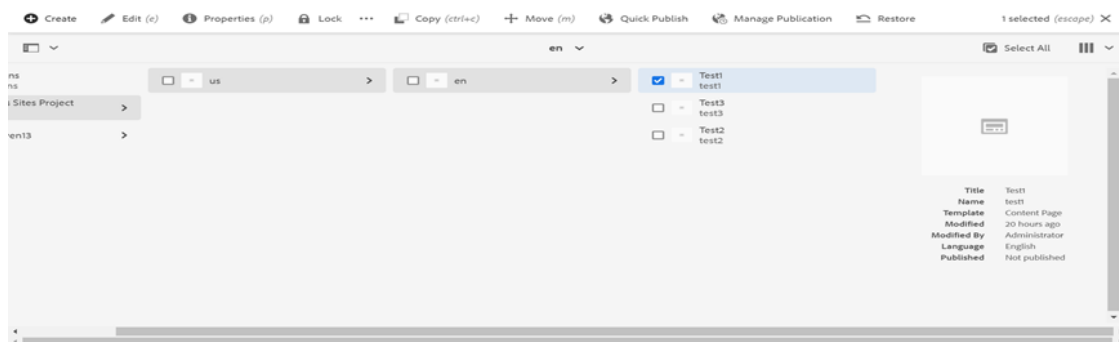
3 Design

The Text Image Component is normal component.

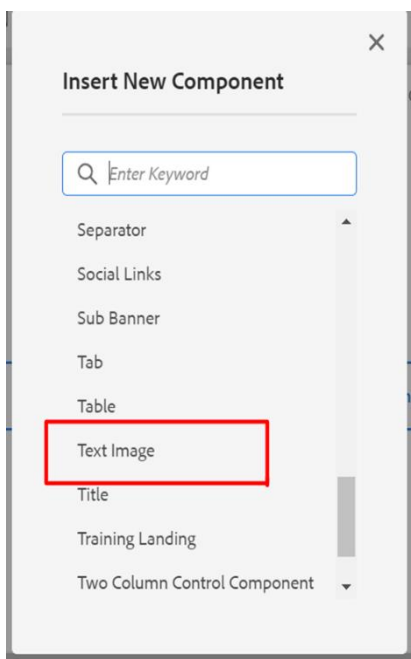
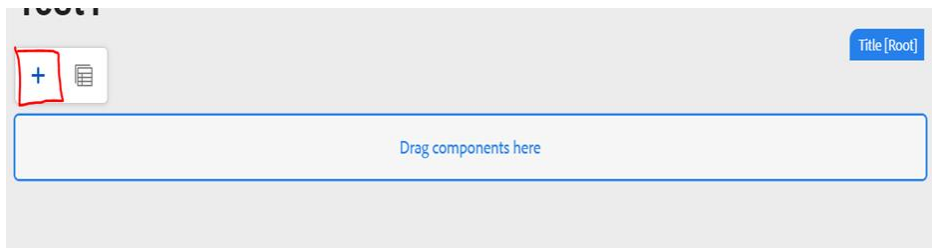
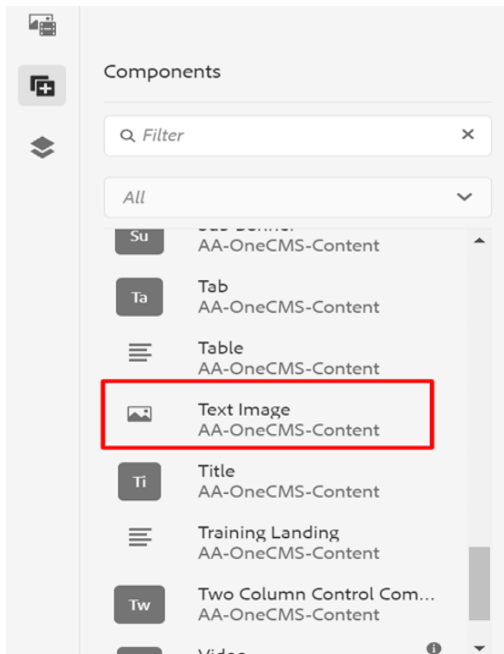
The Text Image component contains the authoring for Title, Image, Image Alt Text, Padding, Image width, Target, Image Position, URL Path to redirect, Description (RTE).

4 Authoring Steps

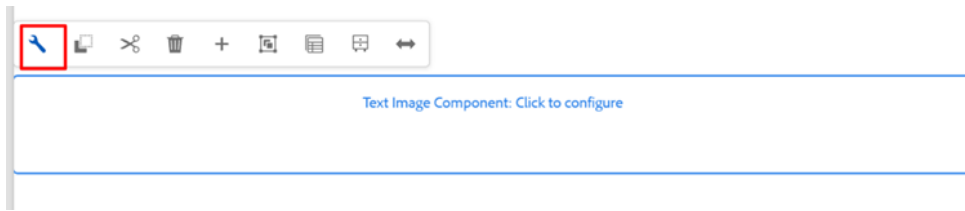
- **Step 1:** Create a new page or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.




- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, go to the content panel from the top left side panel and then click on the component tab and Drag the Text Image Component from the left side panel and drop it inside the Layout Container. Or choose it from the available component list

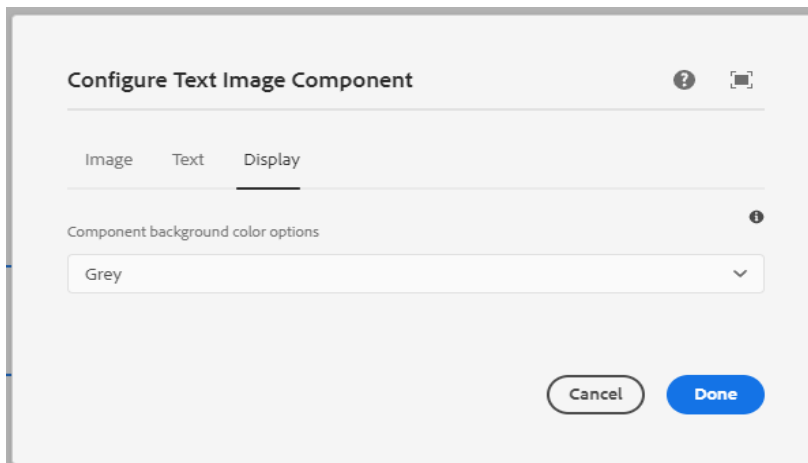
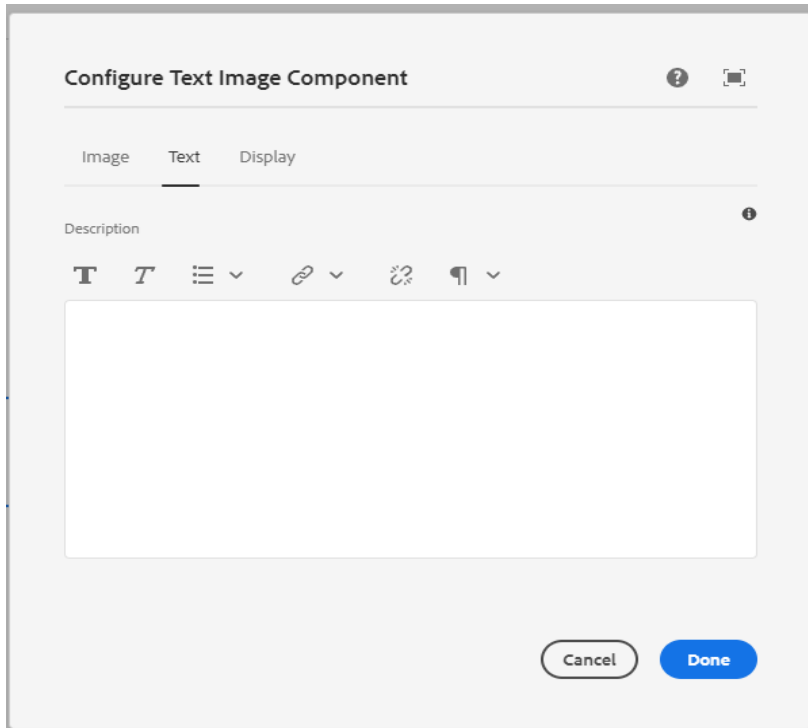


- **Step 3:** Select the Text Image component and click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.



- **Step 4:** Enter the Text Image details in Text Image Dialog as per below snap.





➤ Step 5: Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table.

- Step 6: Click “Done” once you have entered all these details. Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table.
- Step 7: The Text Image will now be visible on the Page and can be previewed.
