Component: Warranty Cards

1 Overview

The Warranty Cards component allows web authors to display cards, where author can put content over the card and each card can have multiple descriptions. Author can put hyperlinks on the description, and they can also perform styling over the content

2 Business Use Case

It is a way to define the UI of the Warranty cards with content editing features based on the business requirement.

3 Design

This Warranty Cards component has properties where author can choose one or more cards at a time to display and with different content. To display any card, web authors need to first author the Title field as it is mandatory.

There are 2 Tabs inside Warranty Cards Component and below are the properties inside each Tabs.


- General
 - Card Title
 - Add Description
- Display
 - Component Background Color Options






4 Authoring Steps

➤ <u>Step 1</u>: Create a new page with Base page template or open an existing page by selecting the page and click on Edit option.




➤ <u>Step 2</u>: Once the Page is opened author can select the Warranty Cards component from the available component list.













> Step 3: Click on 'Warranty Cards: Click to configure' and then click on the wrench icon to open the component dialog.








> Step 4: Enter the desired properties in the Warranty Cards Dialog as per below example:










Here we have a Card Title field to provide a title to a card. It is a mandatory field and after this we have Add Description field, by clicking on Add button, you can author multiple Description for a particular card. We can perform styling over description and can also add hyperlinks to it.

After that, we have Display Tab which contains "component background color options" field which is basically a dropdown, and it offers 2 options which are Grey and White which you can see below.







- Note: For any help regarding the mentioned property, author can click on help icon displayed against each property.
- > Step 5: Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table:

S. No	Field Title	Field Type	Field Description	Mandatory (Yes/No)
1	Title	Text Field	Enter the Title for a card.	Yes
2	Add Description	Text Field	Enter the description for a particular card and you have more than one description for one card.	No
3	Component Background color options	Dropdown	Select the option from dropdown for display component background color.	No

- > Step 6: Click "Done" once author enters all the details.
- > Step 7: The component will now be visible on the Page with text configured and can be previewed.
