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# Component: My Order Status

## 1 Overview

My Order Status Component lets you author the Orders status columns and actions links under dashboard that the author wants the user to see.

## 2 Business Use Case

It allows authors to author the headings of “My Orders Status” table.

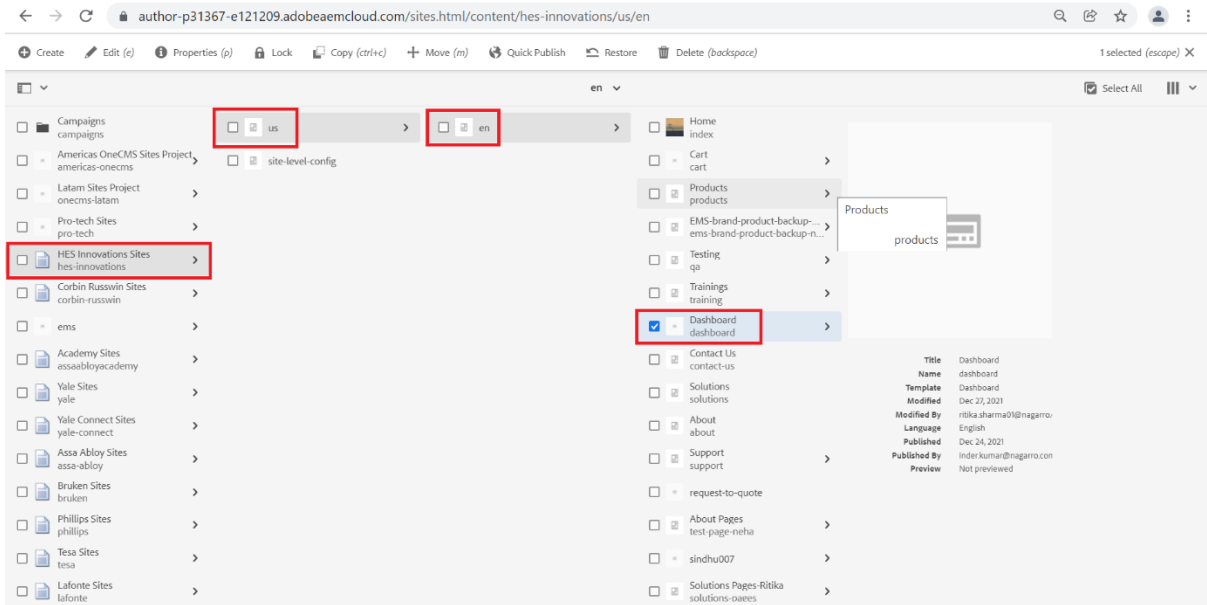
## 3 Design

The “My Orders Status” table contains the authoring for:

- Dashboard Page title.
- “My Orders Status” – confirmed tab title.
- “My Orders Status” – submitted tab title.
- “My Orders Status” – completed tab title.
- “My Orders Status” – cancelled tab title.
- Request to return URL
- Request to edit/cancel URL
- Reorder Cart URL
- View All Orders URL

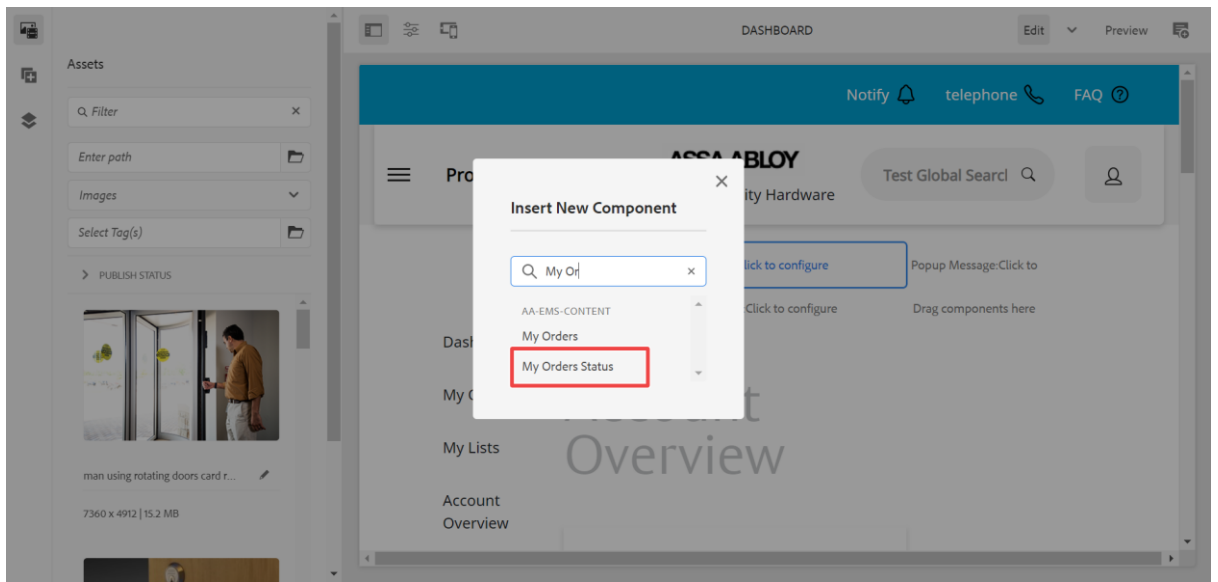
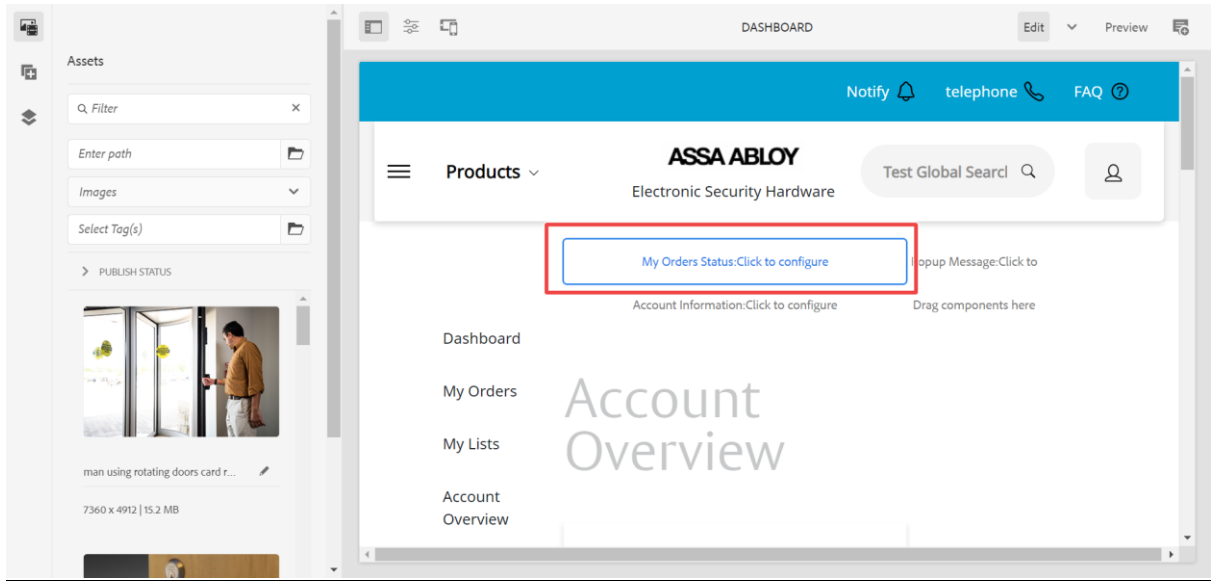
## 4 Authoring Steps

- **Step 1:** Create a new page with “Dashboard” template or open an existing page with by selecting the page and click on Edit option.

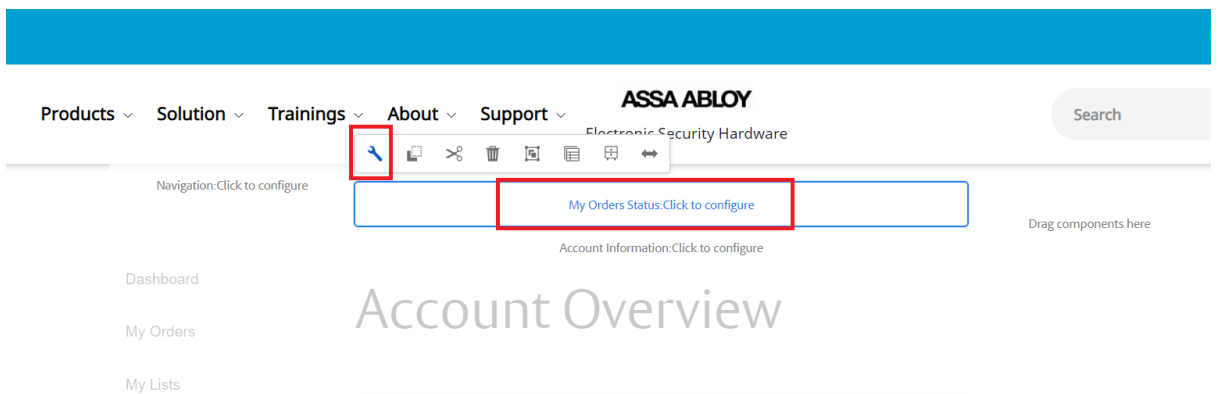


**Note:** Here Language for the created page is English, multiple languages are supported and author can create the page in desired language. The language in which the page is created will be displayed here.

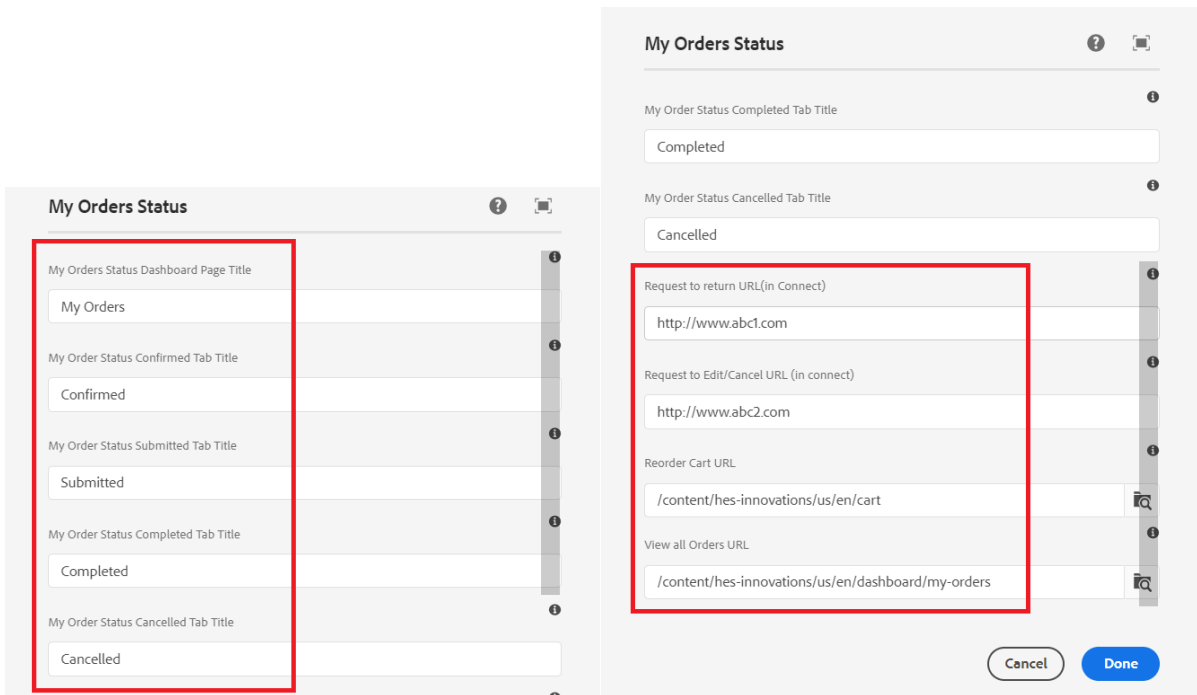
- **Step 2:** Once the Page is opened, by default Dashboard page Heading will be there as part of the Dashboard template. If you have selected any other template, then choose it from the available component list.



➤ Step 3: Click on the “My Orders Status” Wrench Icon to initiate authoring the component.



➤ **Step 4:** Enter the desired text as per the below snaps.



➤ **Step 5** Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table:

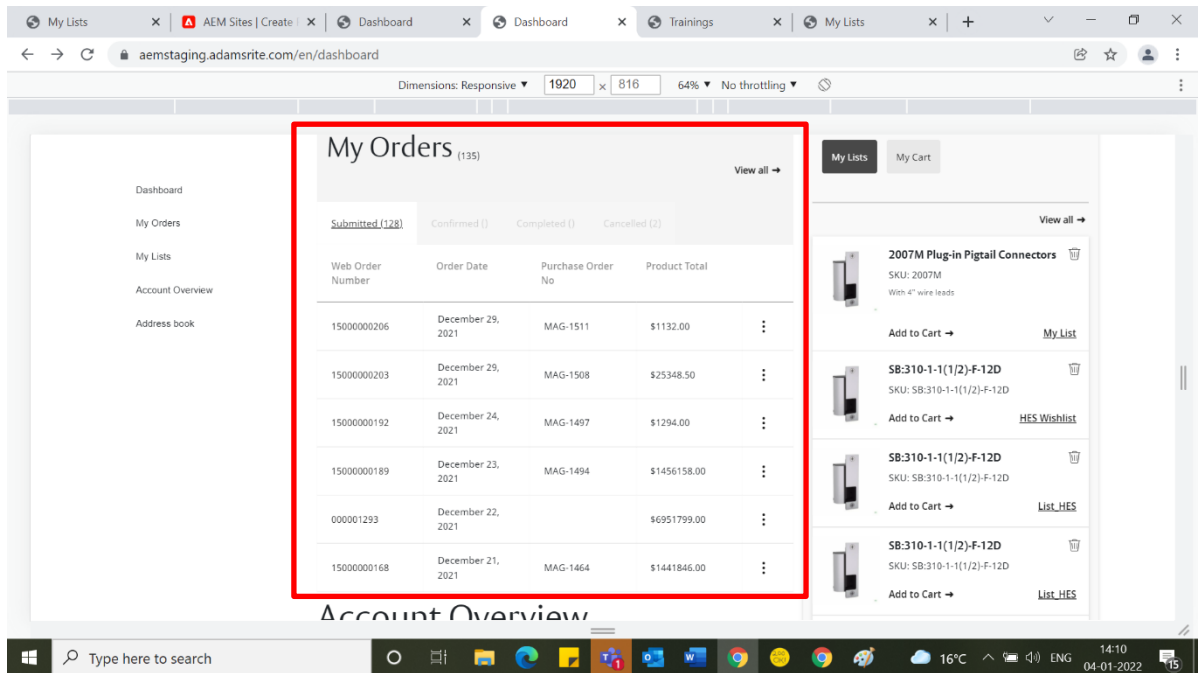

- Step 7: The My Order Status components will now be visible on the Page and can be previewed.

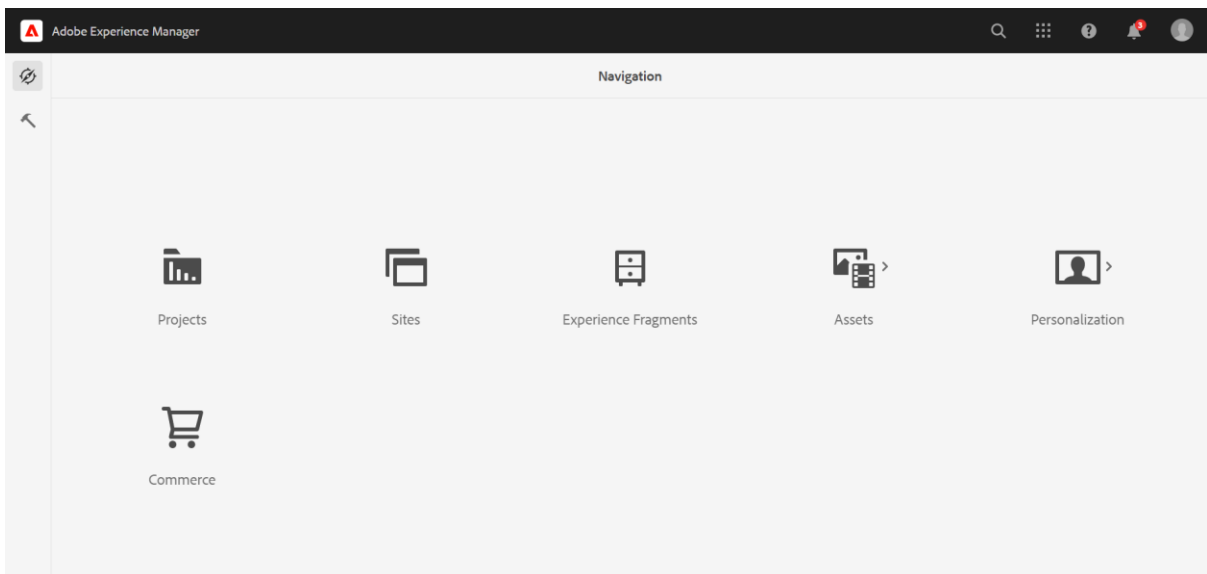
### Steps to Create new Page

- Step 1: Login into AEM portal with valid credentials

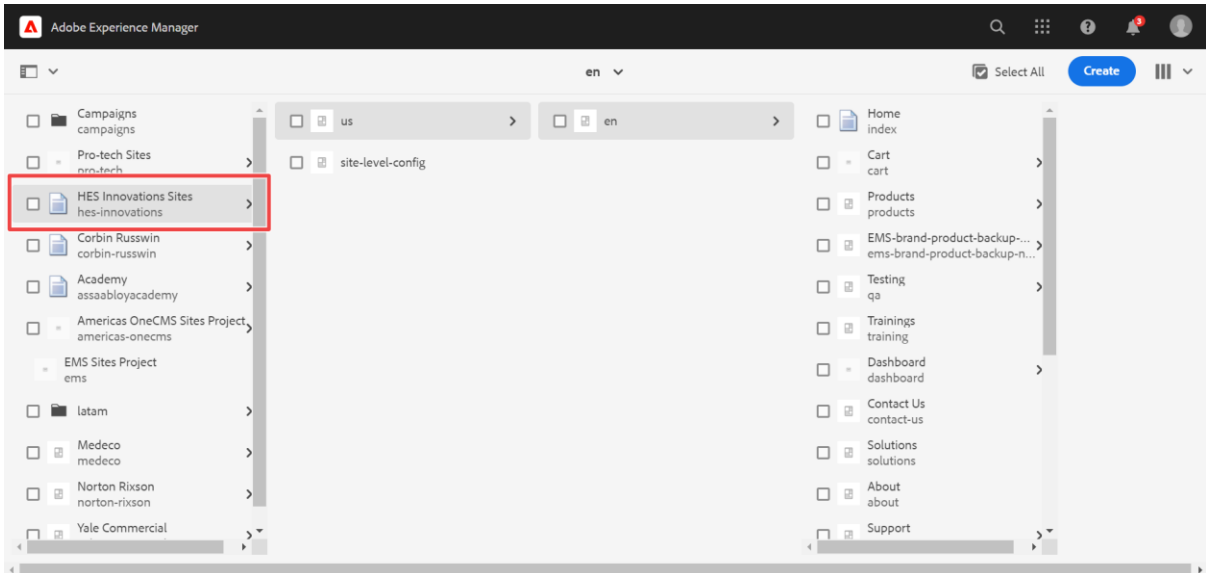


 **Note:** Author should have permission to create and modify the pages.

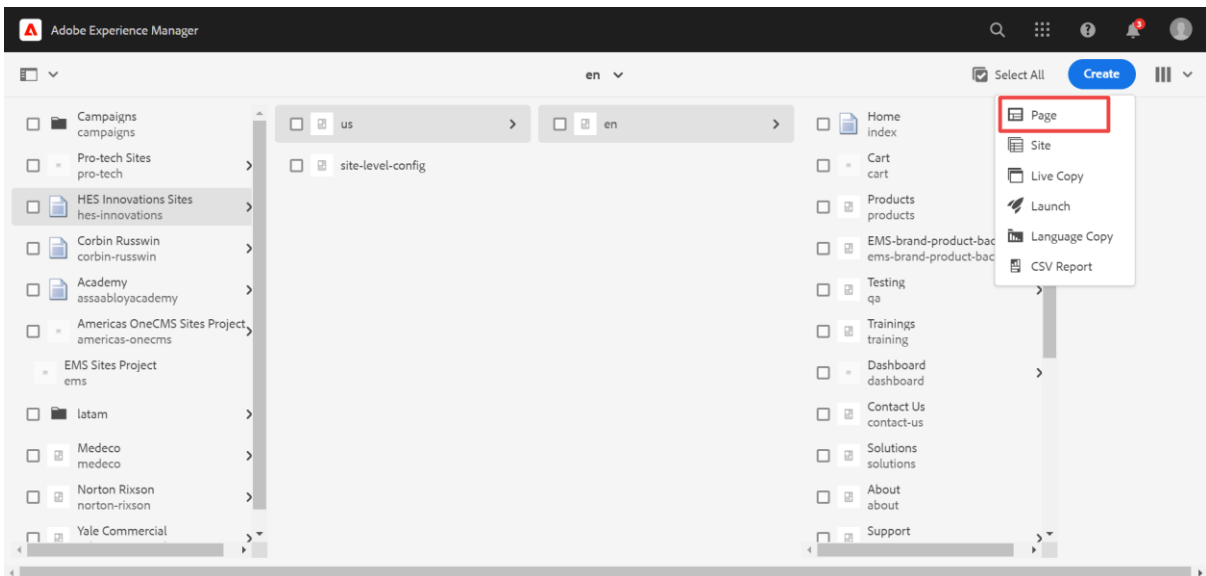
- Step 2: Once user logs into the AEM portal. Below screen should be displayed.



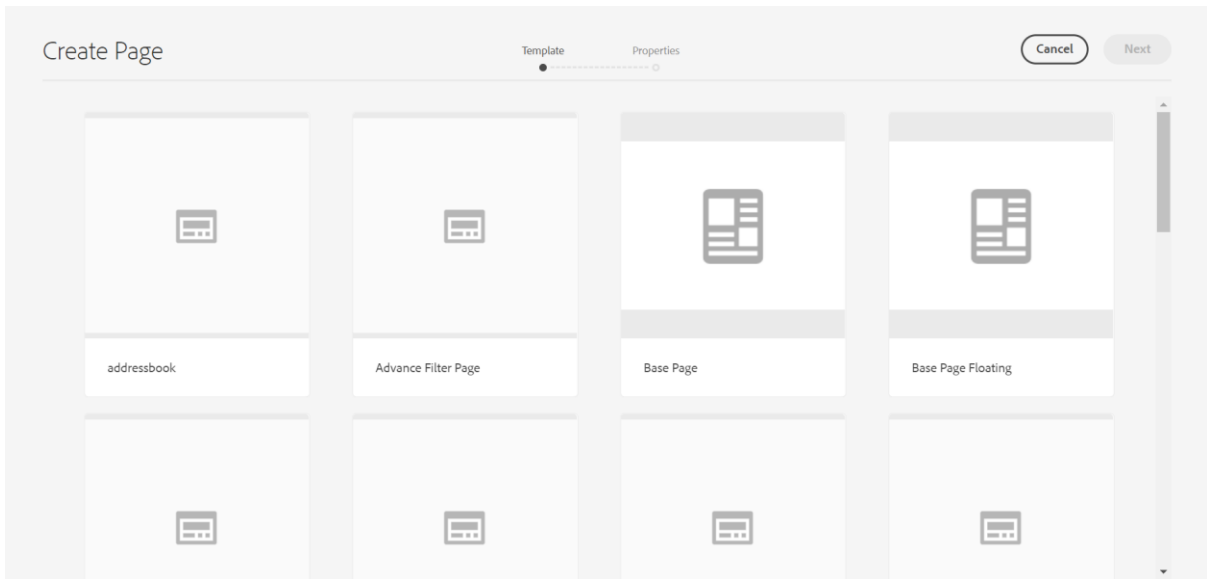
- Step 3: Now click on Sites.



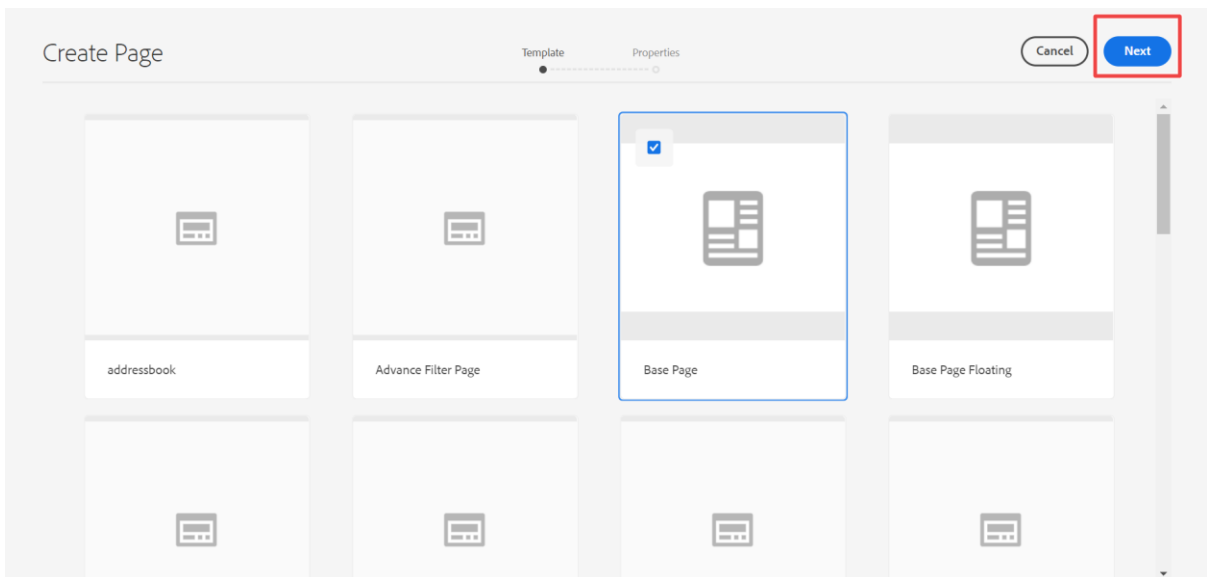
- Step 4: Navigate to HES Innovations Sites>us>en. Author can see the hierarchy of existing pages.
- Step 5: Now click on Create button>Page to create new Page.




- Step 6: Template screen is displayed. Now author can select the desired template from the listed templates.



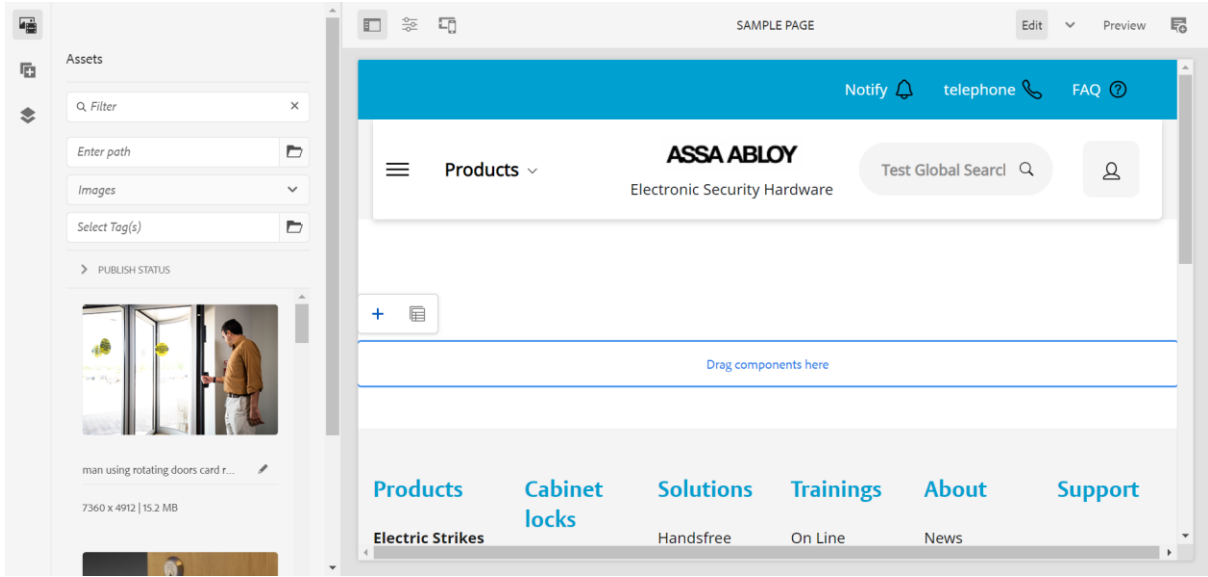
