It allows authors to author the Navigation items under page.

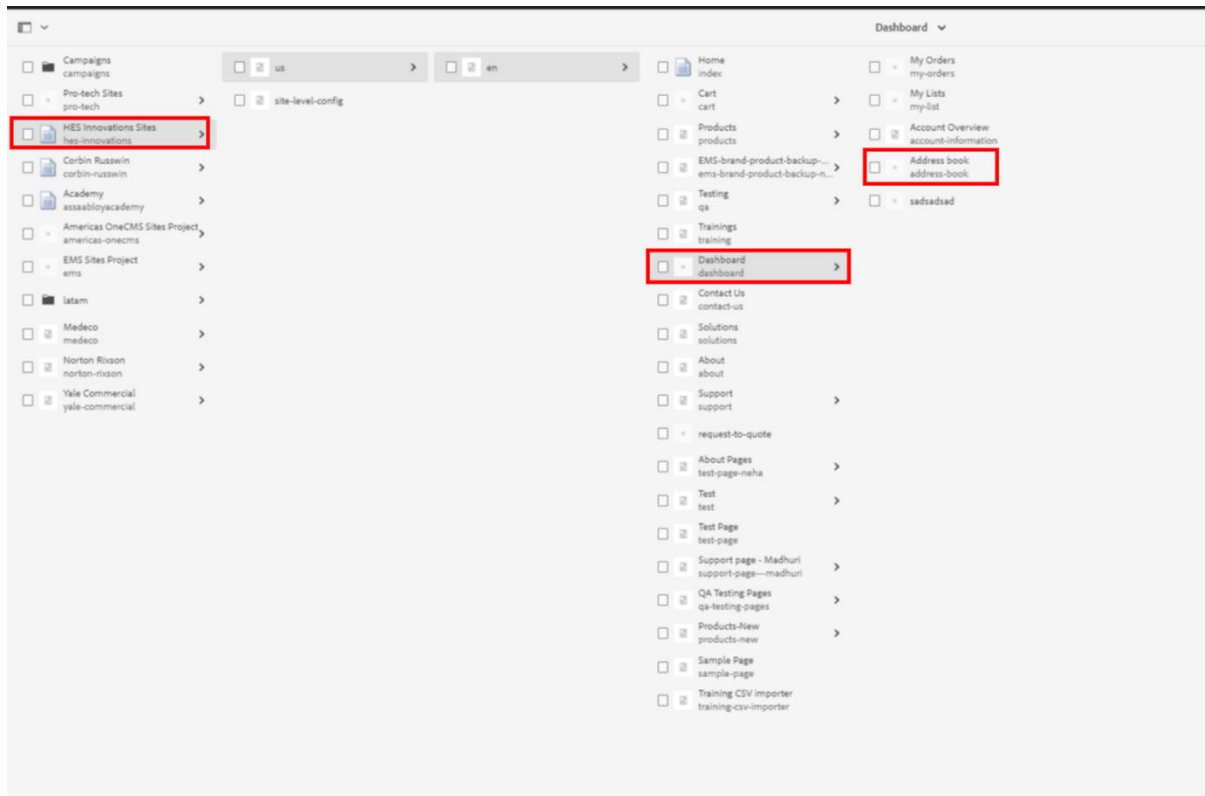
3 Design

- Order Page Checkbox

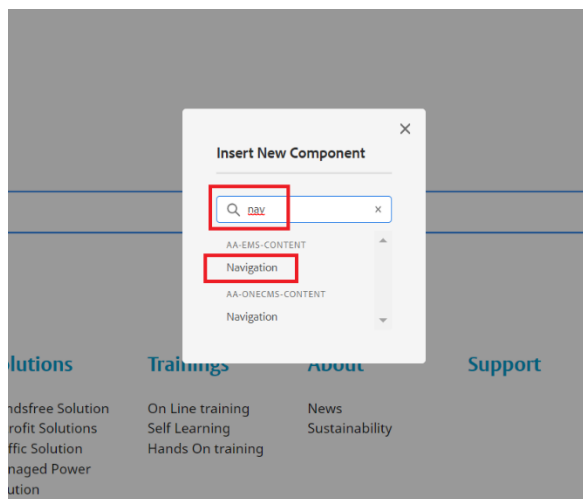
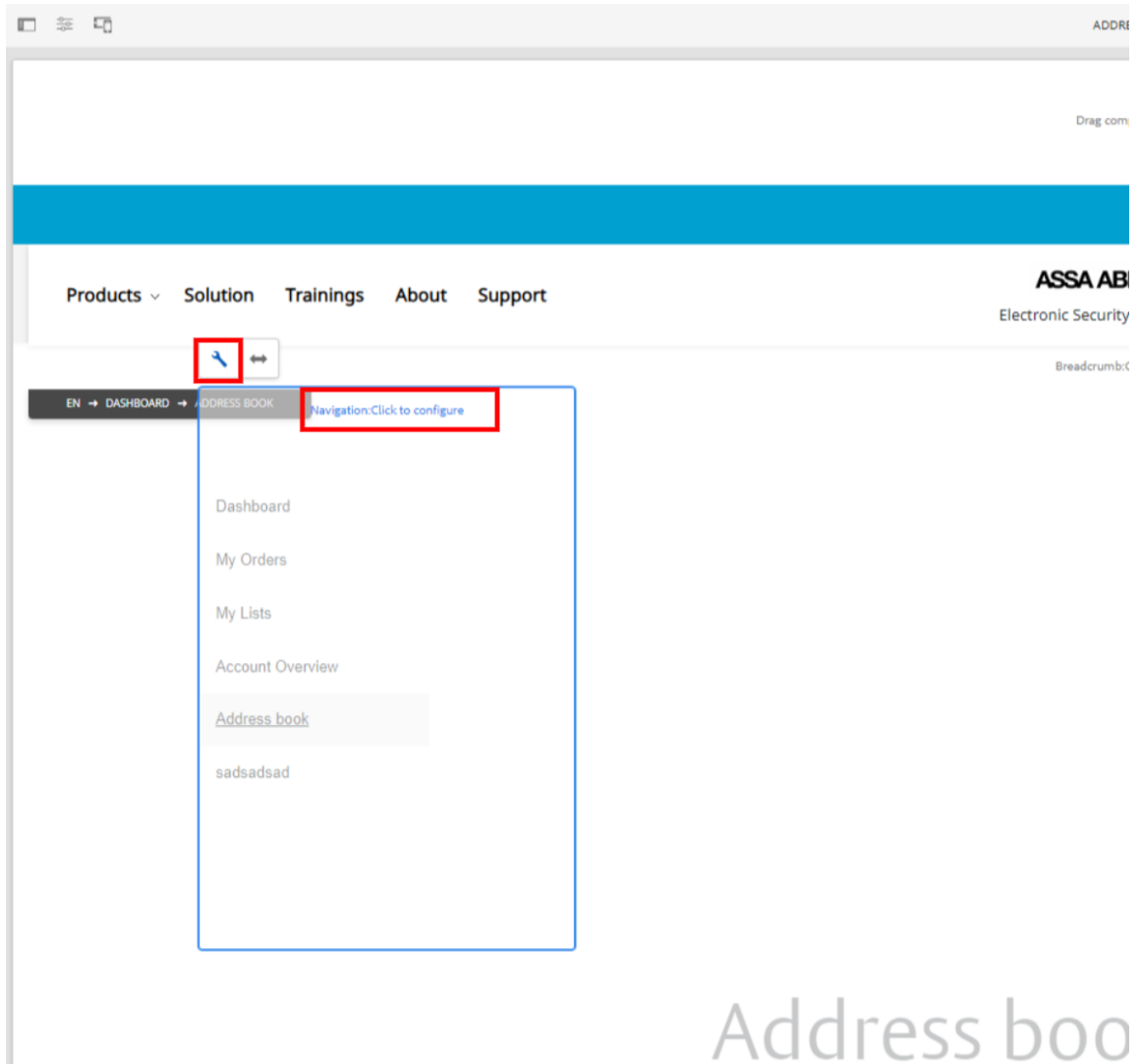
4 Authoring Steps

- **Step 1:** Create a new page with any child template such as Address Book, My List, My Orders template or open an existing page with by selecting the page and click on Edit option.




Note: Here Language for the created page is English, multiple languages are supported and author can create the page in desired language. The language in which the page is created will be displayed here.

- **Step 2:** Click on the “Navigation” Wrench Icon to initiate authoring the component.



➤ Step 3: Enter the desired text as per the below snaps.



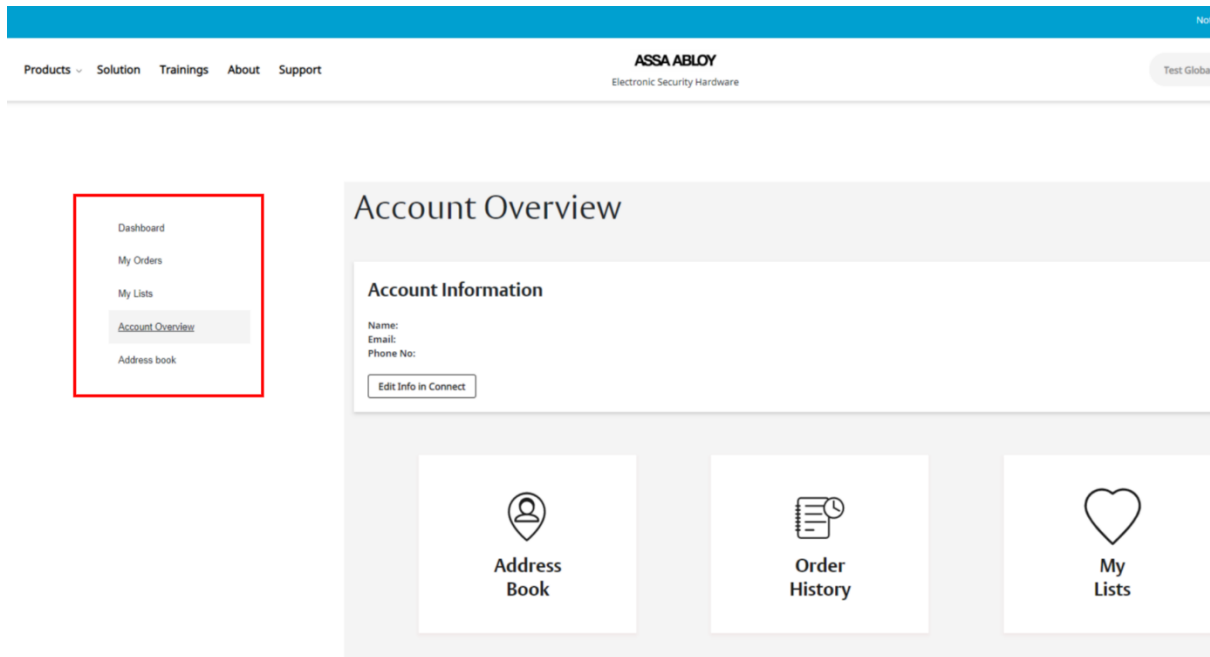


- Step 4: Fill in all the required details in the component dialog as following table:

S. No	Field Title	Field Type	Field Description	Mandatory (Yes/No)
1.	Navigation Root	Path Field	Enter path of parent under which navigation has to added	No
2.	Order Page	Checkbox	Check or Uncheck Order Page	No

- Step 5: Click “Done” once author has entered all these details.
- Step 6: The Navigation component will now be visible on the Page and can be previewed.

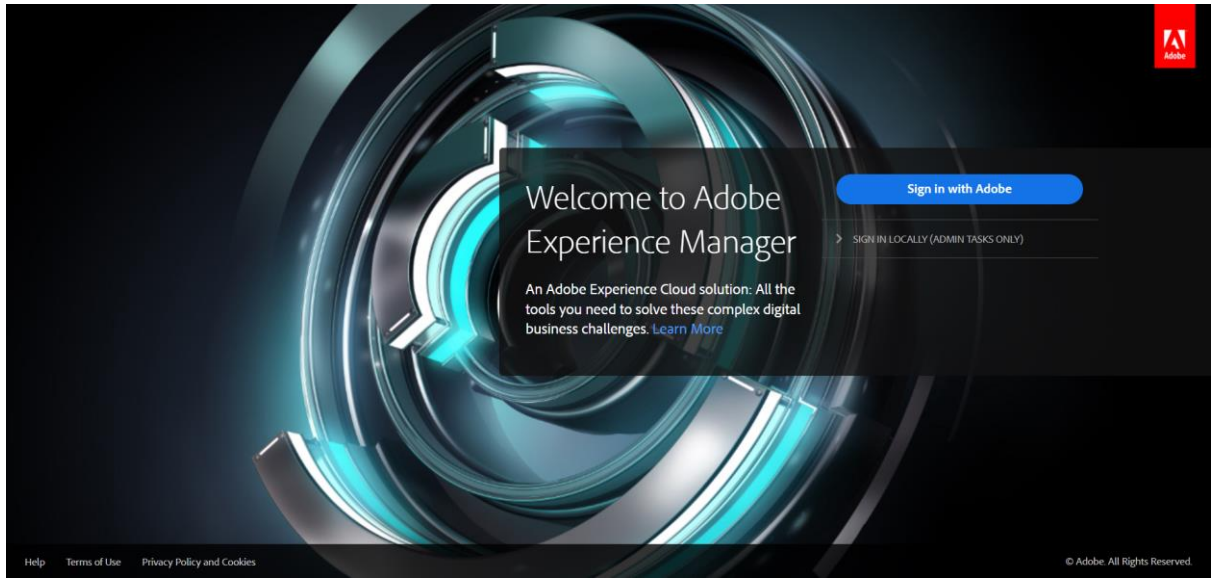

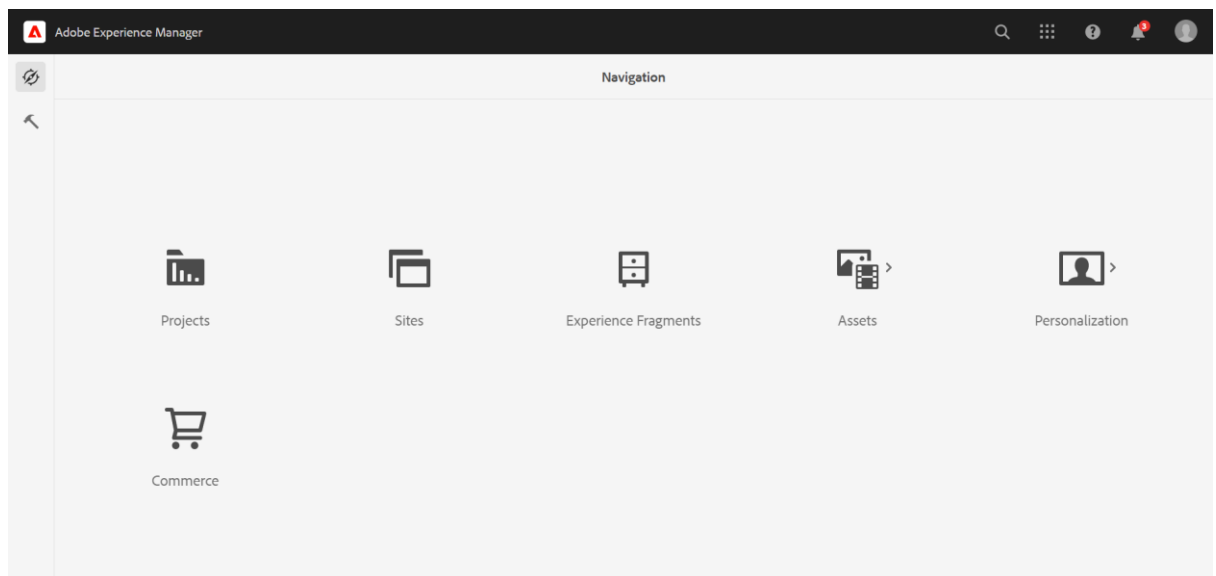
Steps to Create new Page

- Step 1: Login into AEM portal with valid credentials

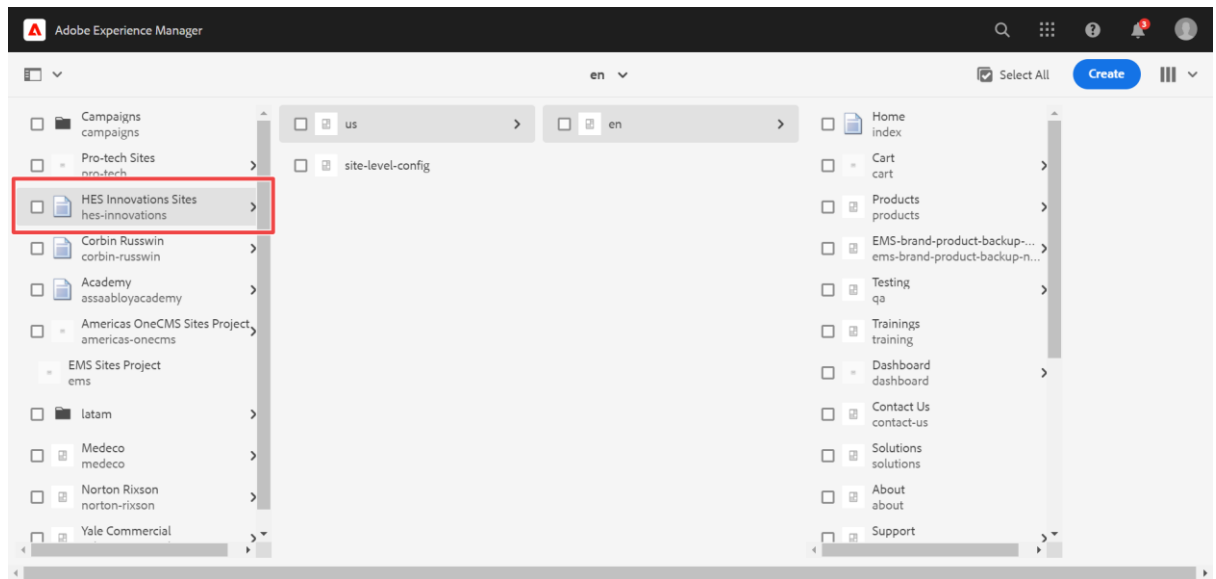


 **Note:** Author should have permission to create and modify the pages.

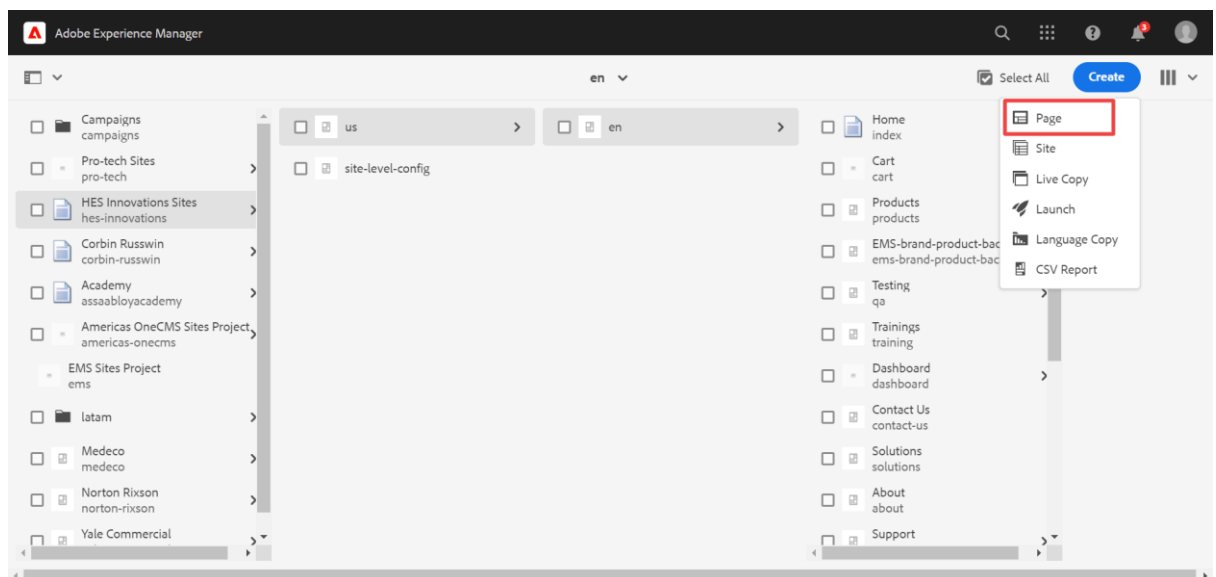
- Step 2: Once user logs into the AEM portal. Below screen should be displayed.



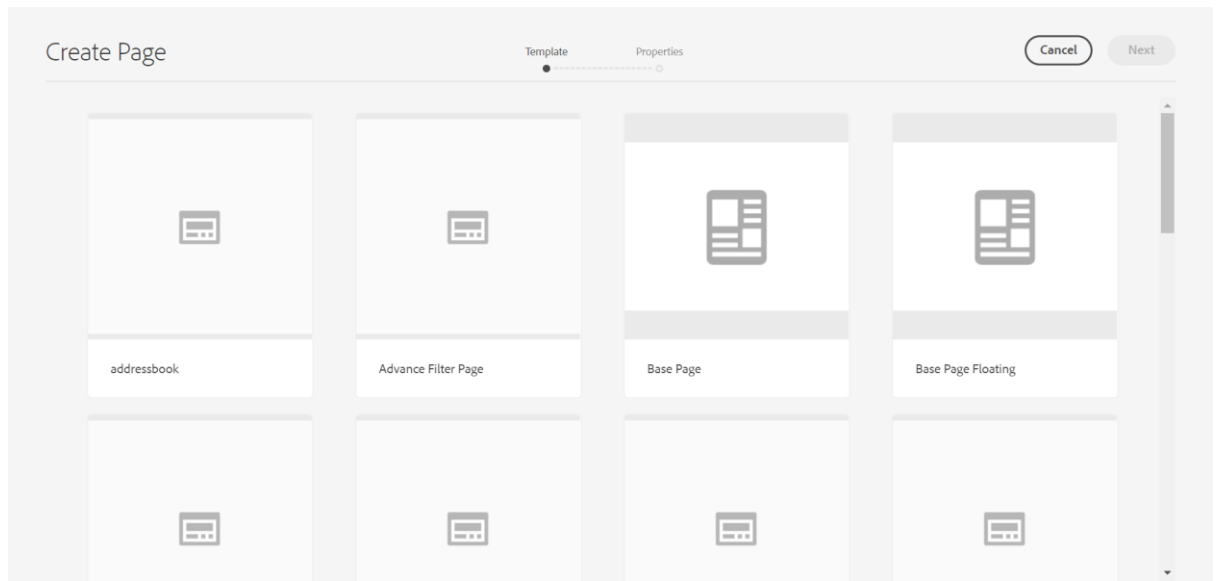
- Step 3: Now click on Sites.



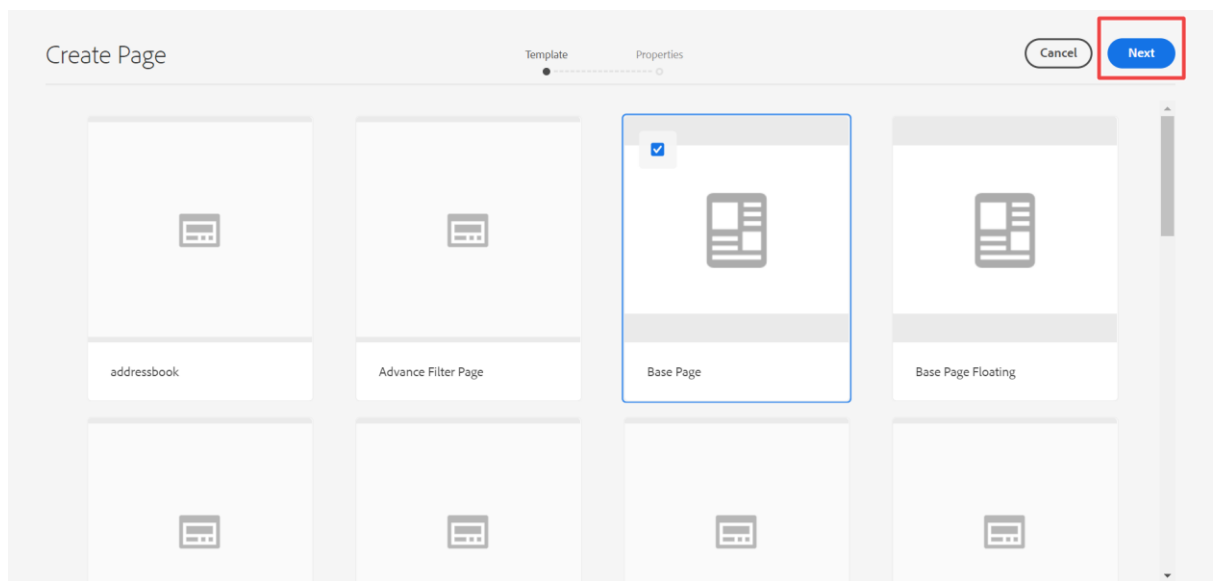
- **Step 4:** Navigate to HES Innovations Sites>us>en. Author can see the hierarchy of existing pages.
- **Step 5:** Now click on Create button>Page to create new Page.




- **Step 6:** Template screen is displayed. Now author can select the desired template from the listed templates.

- Step 8: Now author needs to enter the value for mandatory fields and then click on Create button



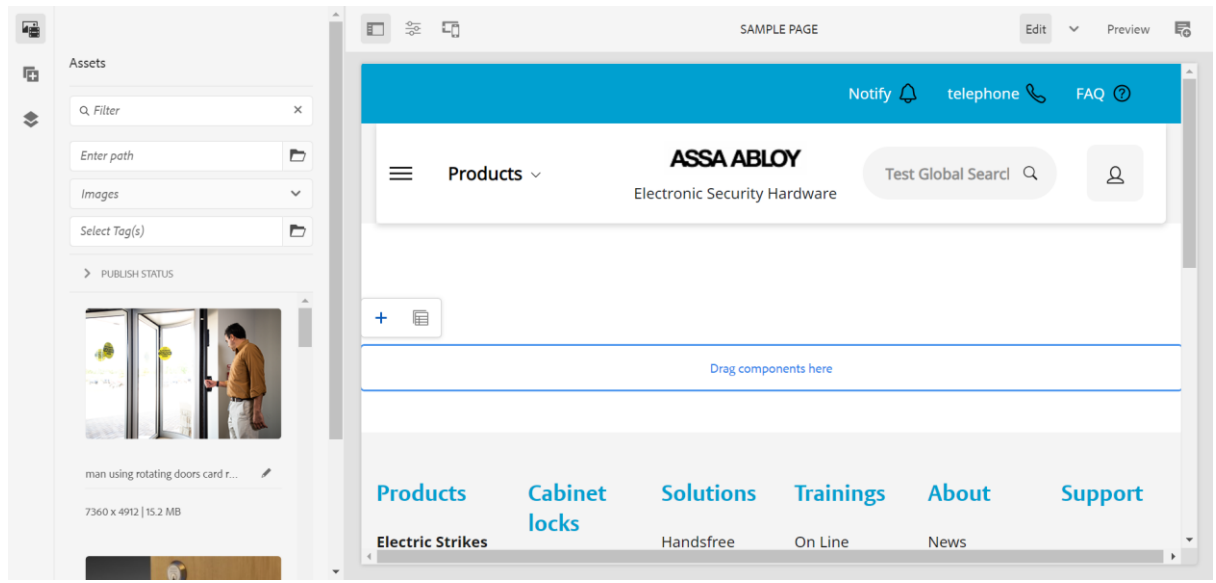
